Trends: People Receiving Substance Use Disorder Treatment by Providers Funded by Vermont Department of Health Division of Alcohol and Drug Abuse Programs

October 2020

Overview

This report includes information about people treated for substance use disorder (SUD) at providers funded by the Vermont Department of Health Division of Alcohol and Drug Abuse Programs (ADAP). These services include outpatient treatment, intensive outpatient treatment, medication assisted treatment (MAT) in opioid treatment programs, and non-hospital based residential detoxification and treatment. Reporting comes from the providers and at times there are reporting gaps that impact trends.

Providers who are not funded by ADAP are not required to submit treatment data. This report does not include SUD treatment provided by private practitioner licensed counselors, hospitals, and medical practitioners who provide SUD treatment. Office based opioid treatment which is known as a “spoke” service in Vermont is also excluded from this report.

Methods

Providers funded by ADAP are required to report treatment admissions, services, and discharges each month to the Substance Abuse Treatment Information System (SATIS). Data are validated when uploaded into the system. Occasionally, data lags or missing data impact trends and when it is substantial, it is noted.

This report is based on the state fiscal year in which a person received treatment services unless otherwise noted. For clarity, this report reflects unduplicated numbers of people served so categories used reflect information associated with the person's most recent admission to care unless otherwise noted. The State of Vermont's fiscal year begins on July 1st and ends on June 30th of the following year.

A person may have been admitted to treatment in a year before the reporting year but continue to receive services in additional years and would appear in each year in which they received service. People may also have been admitted more than once in a year and would appear only once in the report.

- The substance reported is the primary substance used at the time of the most recent admission. People often use more than one substance at once.
- Age is categorized as the person's lowest age during reporting year.
- County is based on the county of residence at the time of the most recent admission

Data are suppressed when fewer than five people are served.

Key takeaways 2019

- Fewer people were served in 2019 than in previous years driven largely by the decrease in people receiving medication assisted treatment for opioid use disorder (OUD) in hubs. Please note that spoke services are not included in this report and have been increasing. [Additional information](#) about hub and spoke services is available on the [ADAP website](#).
- More people continue to receive treatment for opioid use disorder than for any other substance use disorder. Treatment rates are not aligned with use/misuse rates. Alcohol is the [most commonly misused substance](#) in Vermont and Vermont has one of the highest rates of use of any state.
- The number of people under the age of 18 receiving treatment has been trending down and makes up less than 4% of those receiving treatment for the past four years. The number of people age 18-24 has also been decreasing despite having the [highest rate of substance use](#).
- Treatment for marijuana/hashish has been decreasing even as Vermont has been in the process of legalizing adult sales of cannabis. Vermonters under 18 are most likely to receive treatment for marijuana/hashish.
- Treatment for cocaine/crack use increased 65% between 2017 and 2019.

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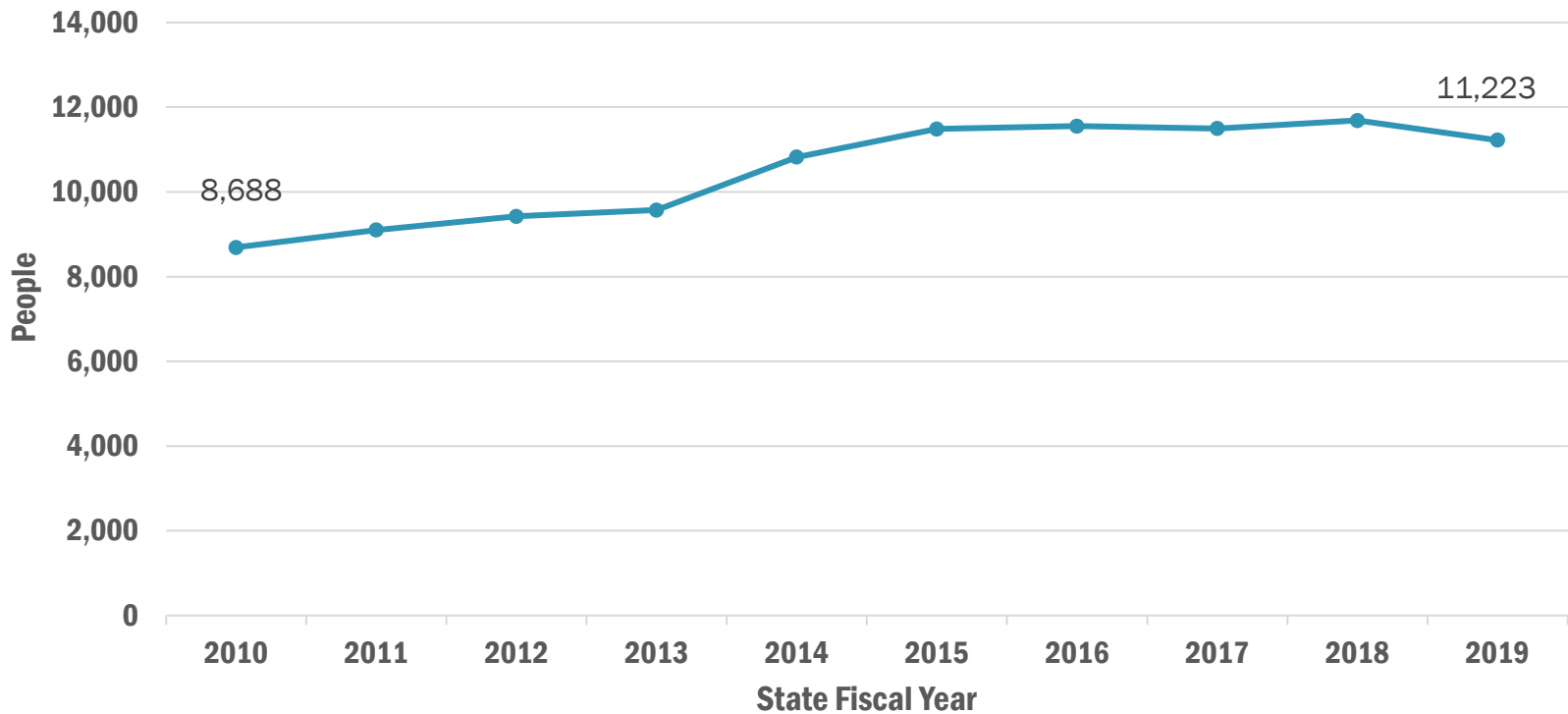
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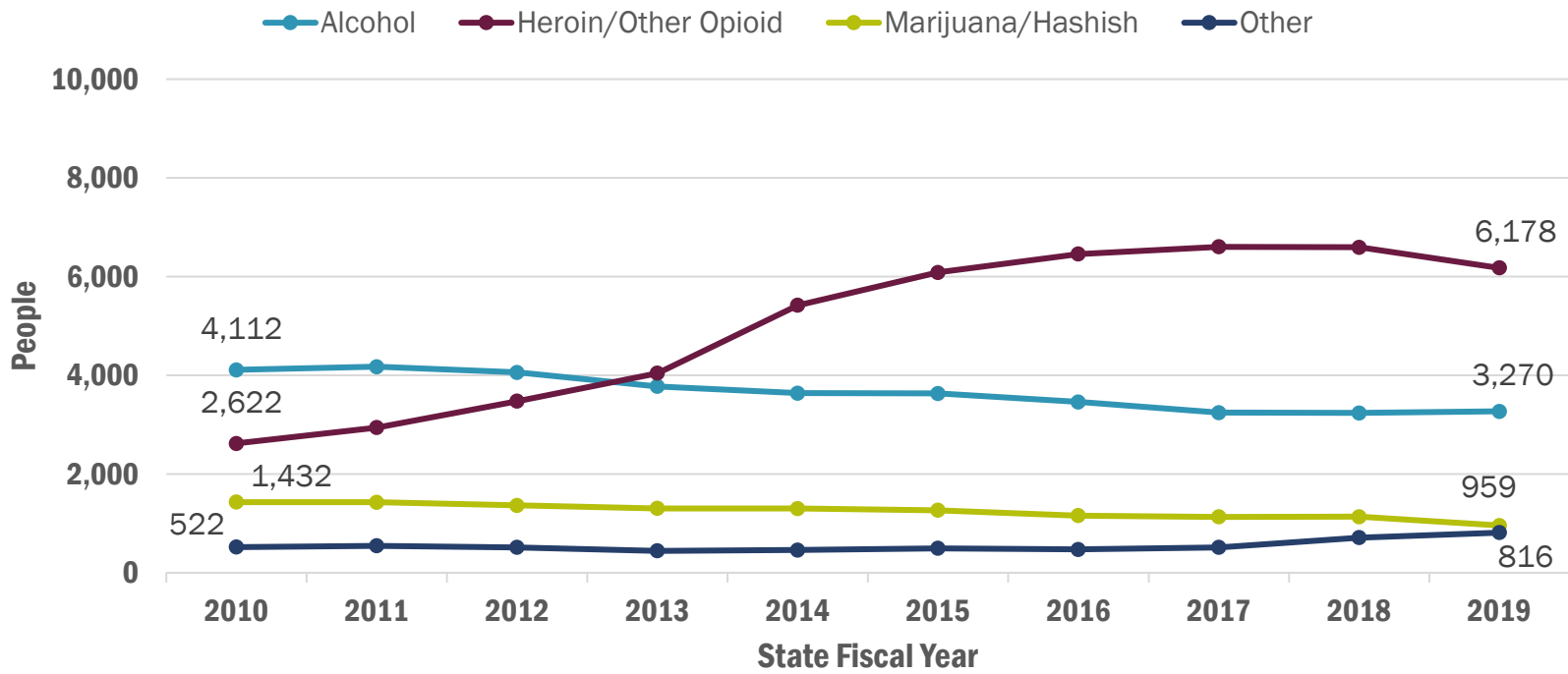
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People Treated for Substance Use Disorder by Fiscal Year

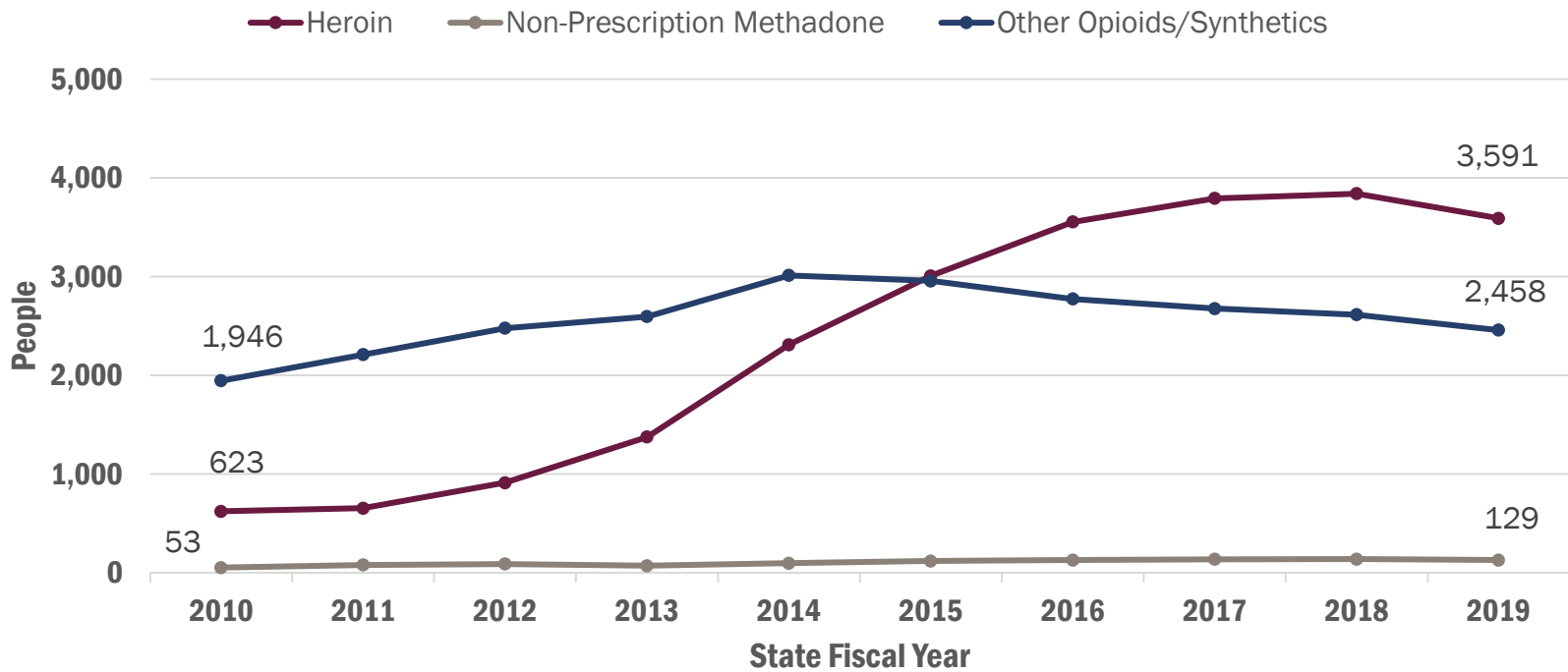

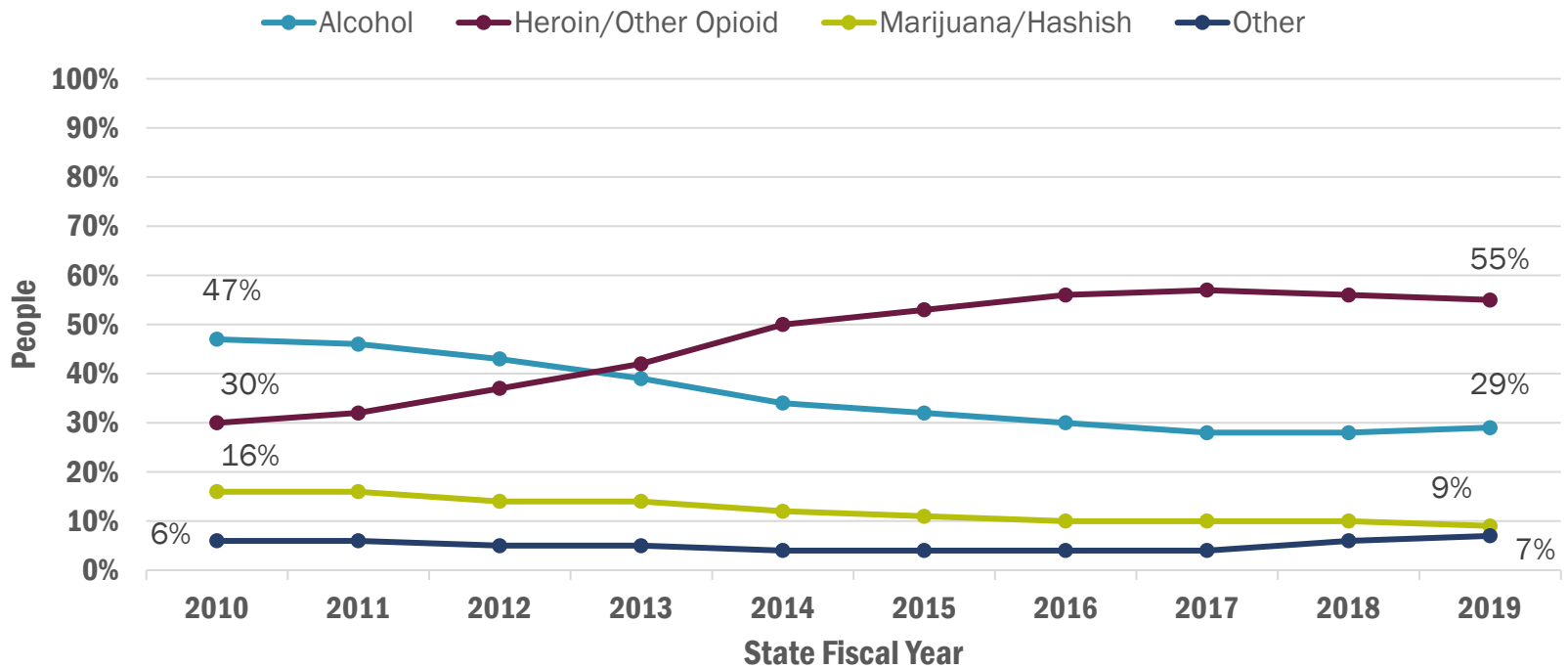
People Treated for Opioid Use Disorder in Vermont by Fiscal Year

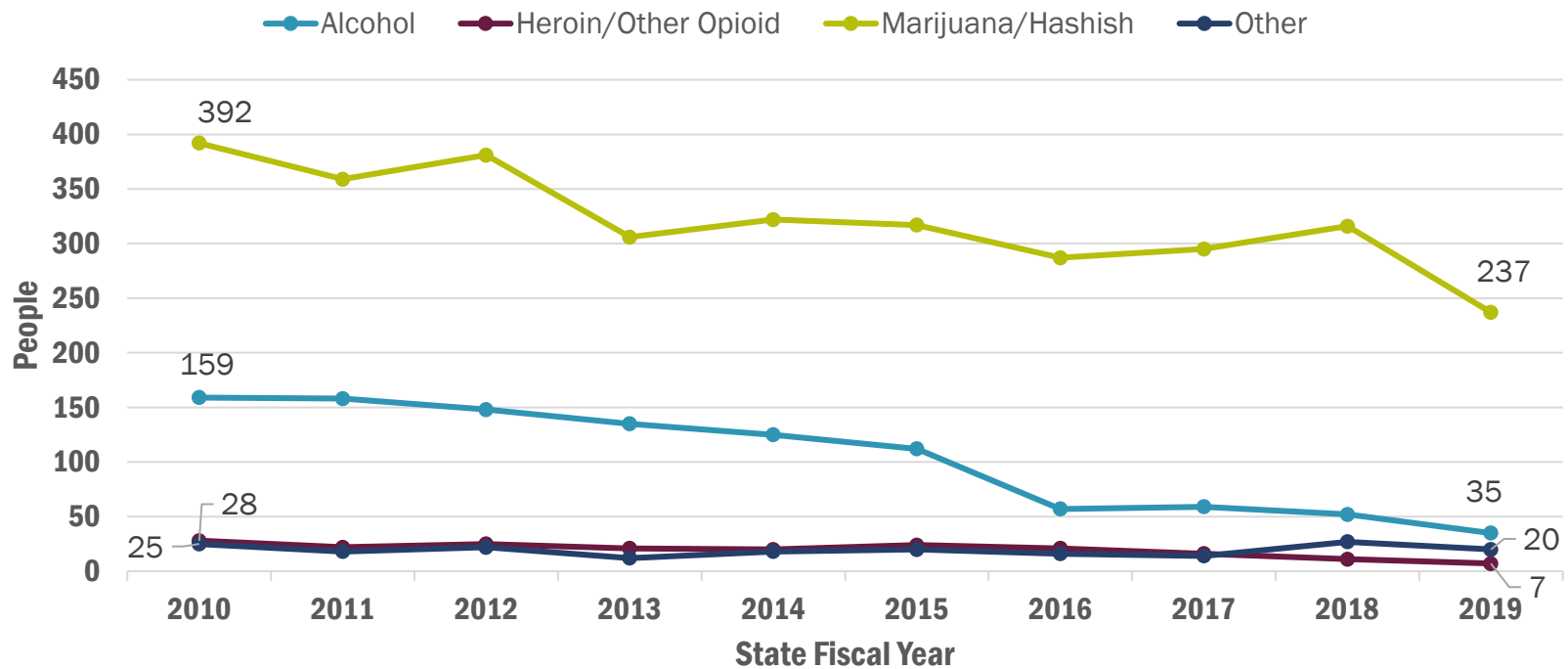

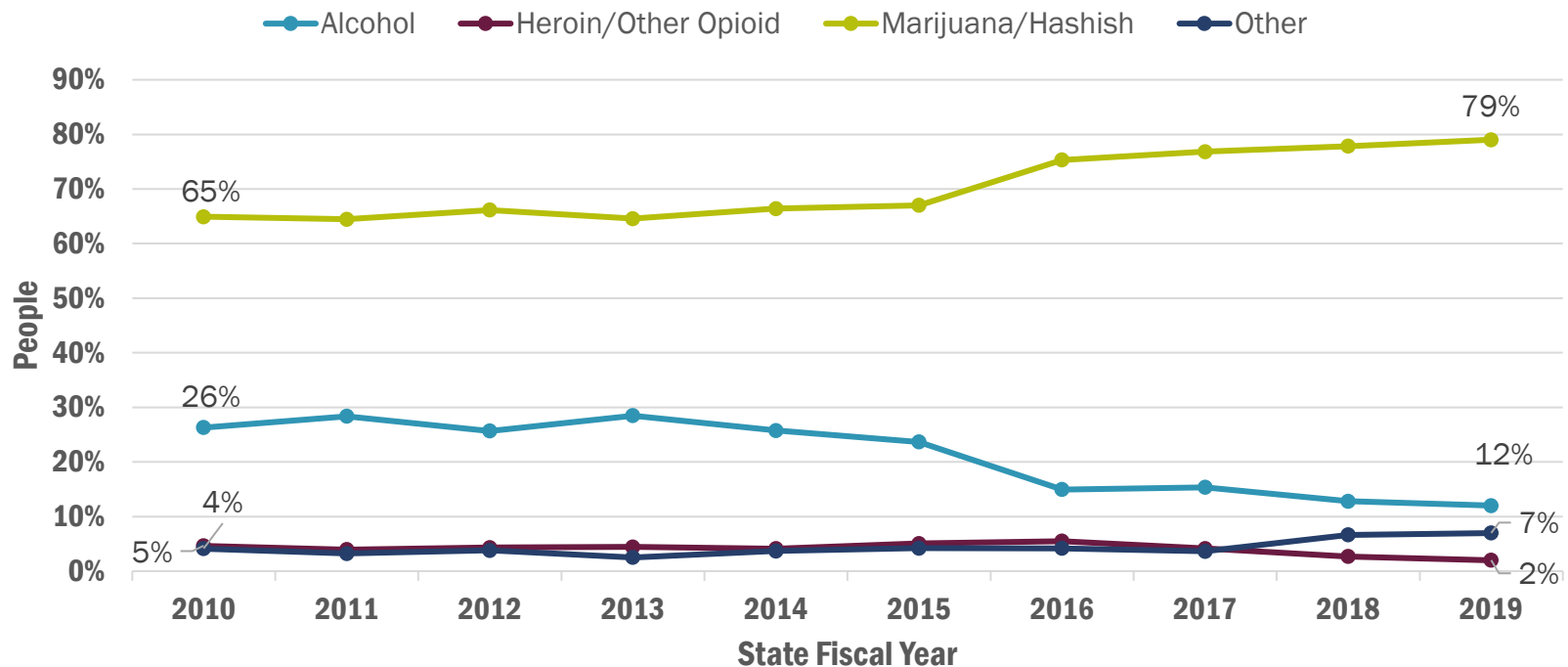

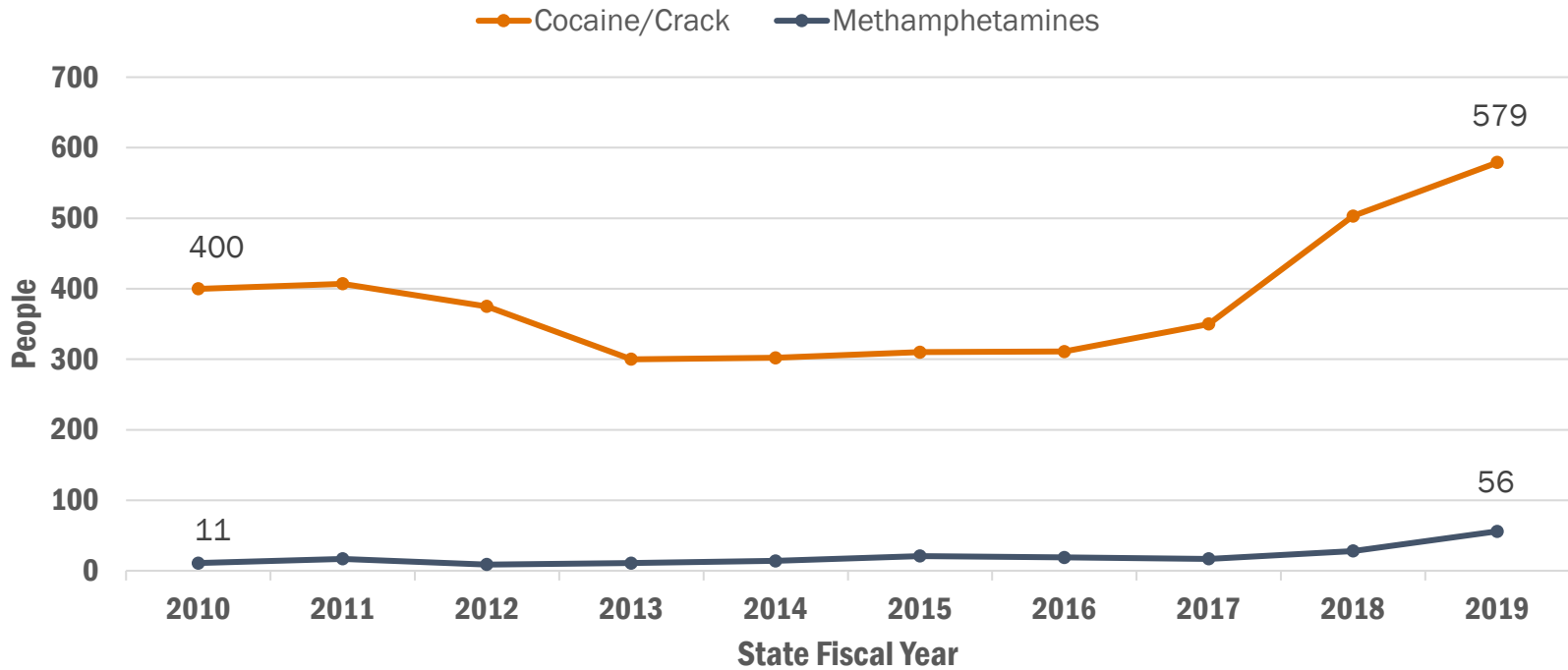

People Treated for Potential Substances of Concern by Fiscal Year

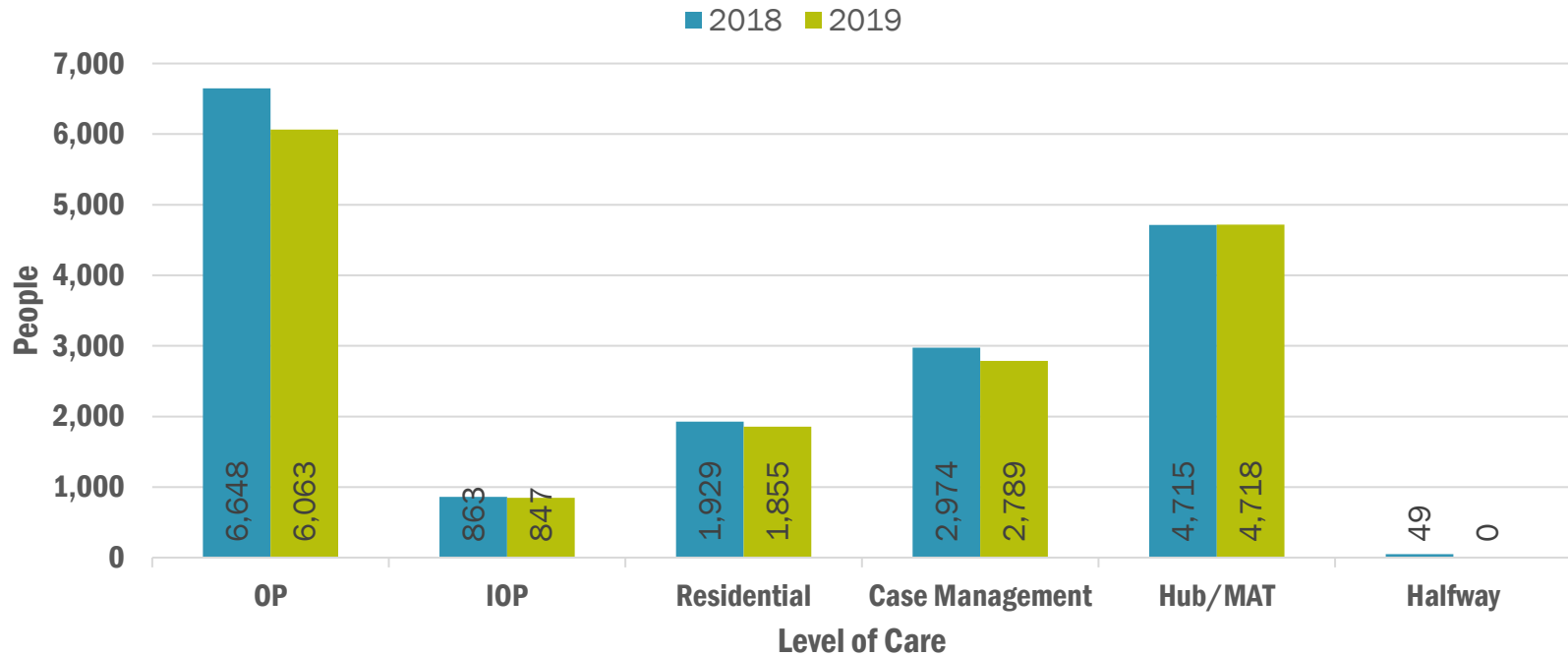

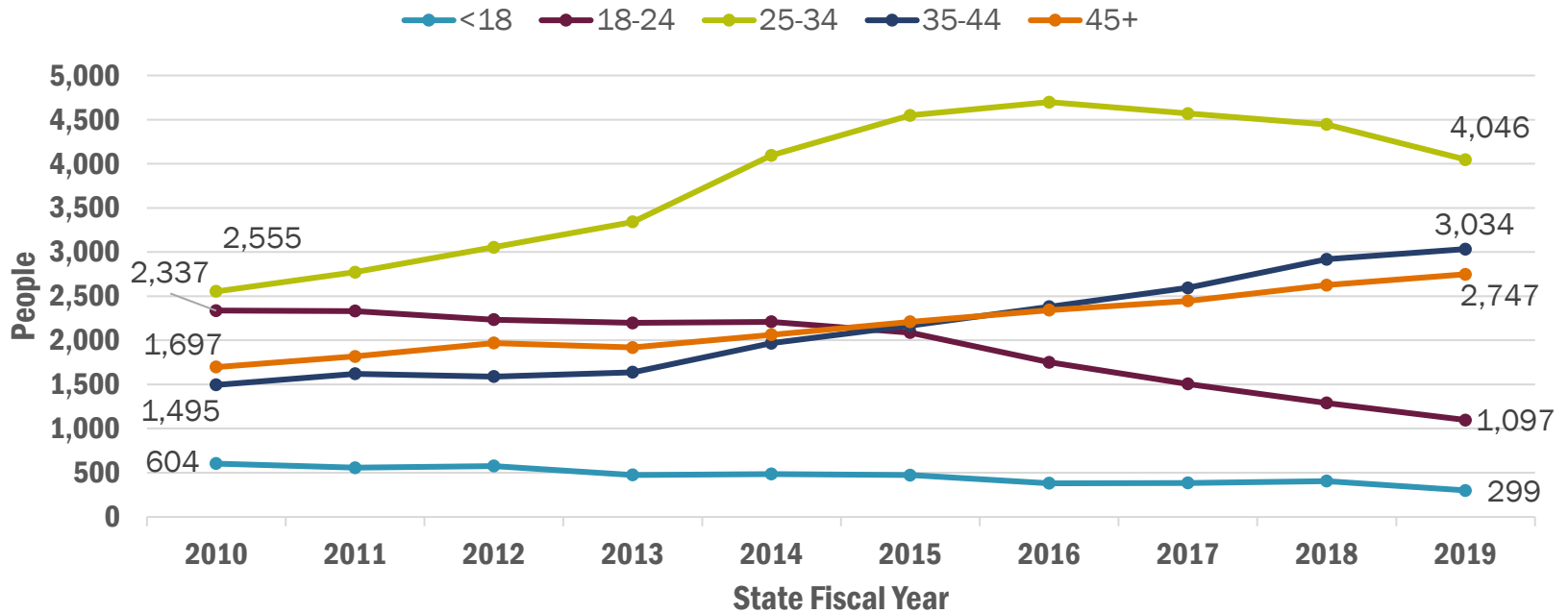

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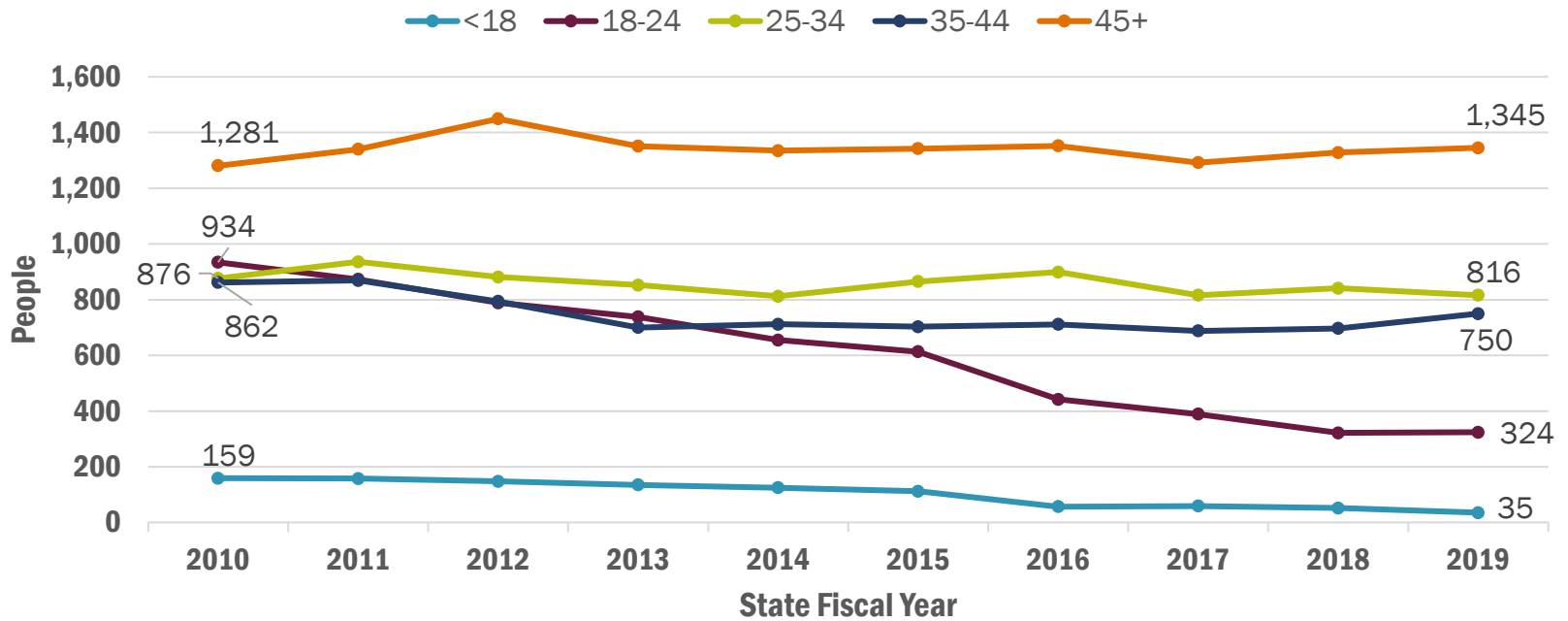

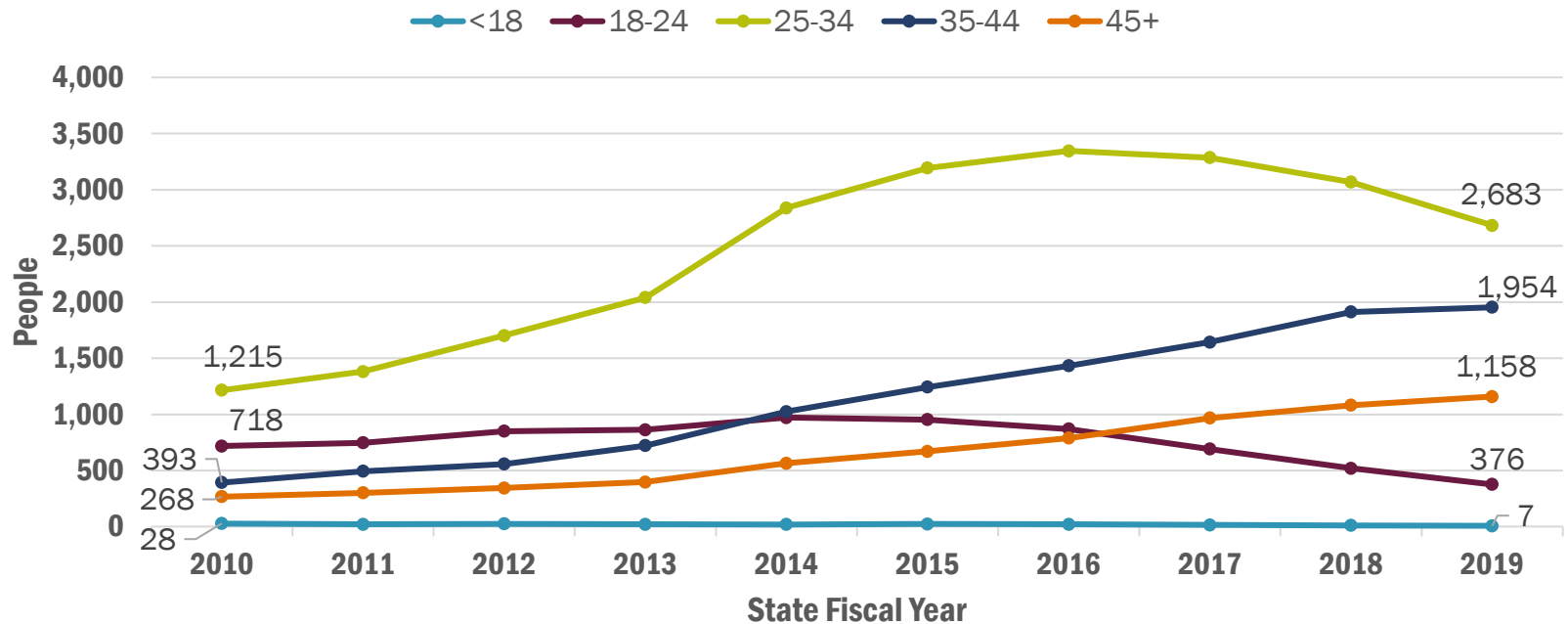
People Treated for Alcohol Use Disorder by Age and Fiscal Year

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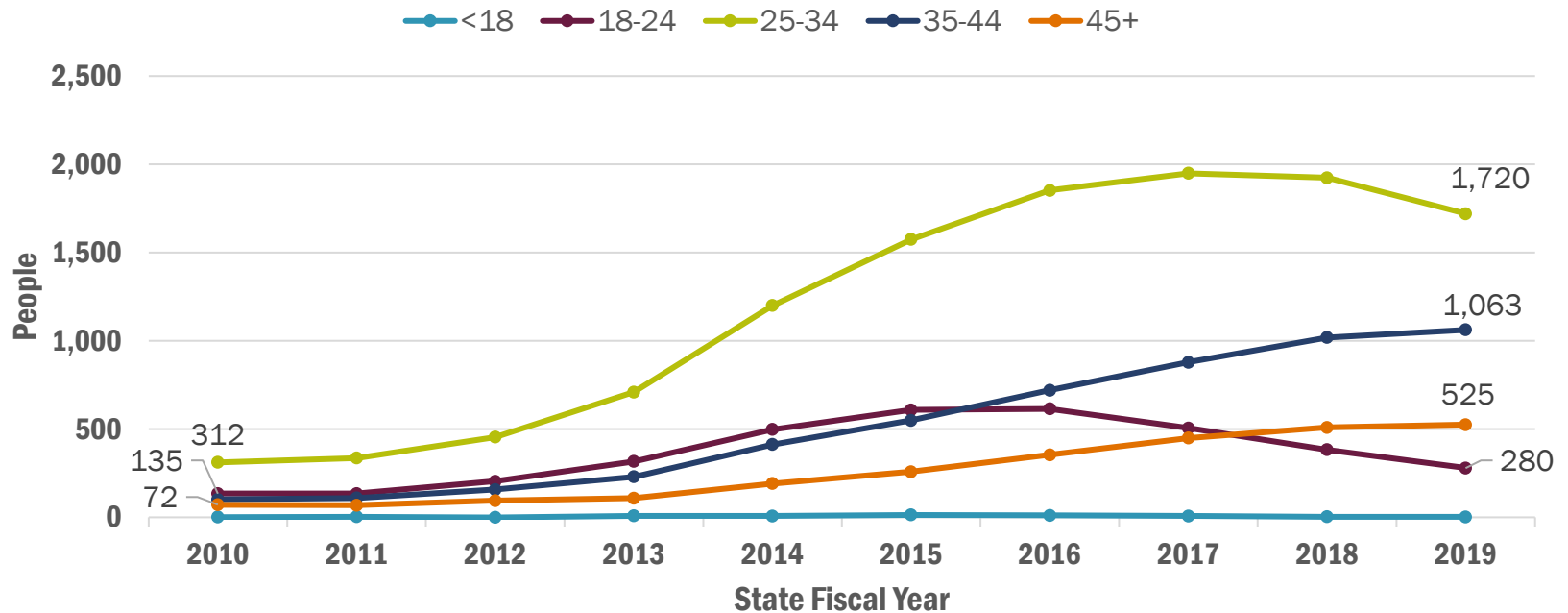
People Treated for Opioid Use Disorder by Age and Fiscal Year

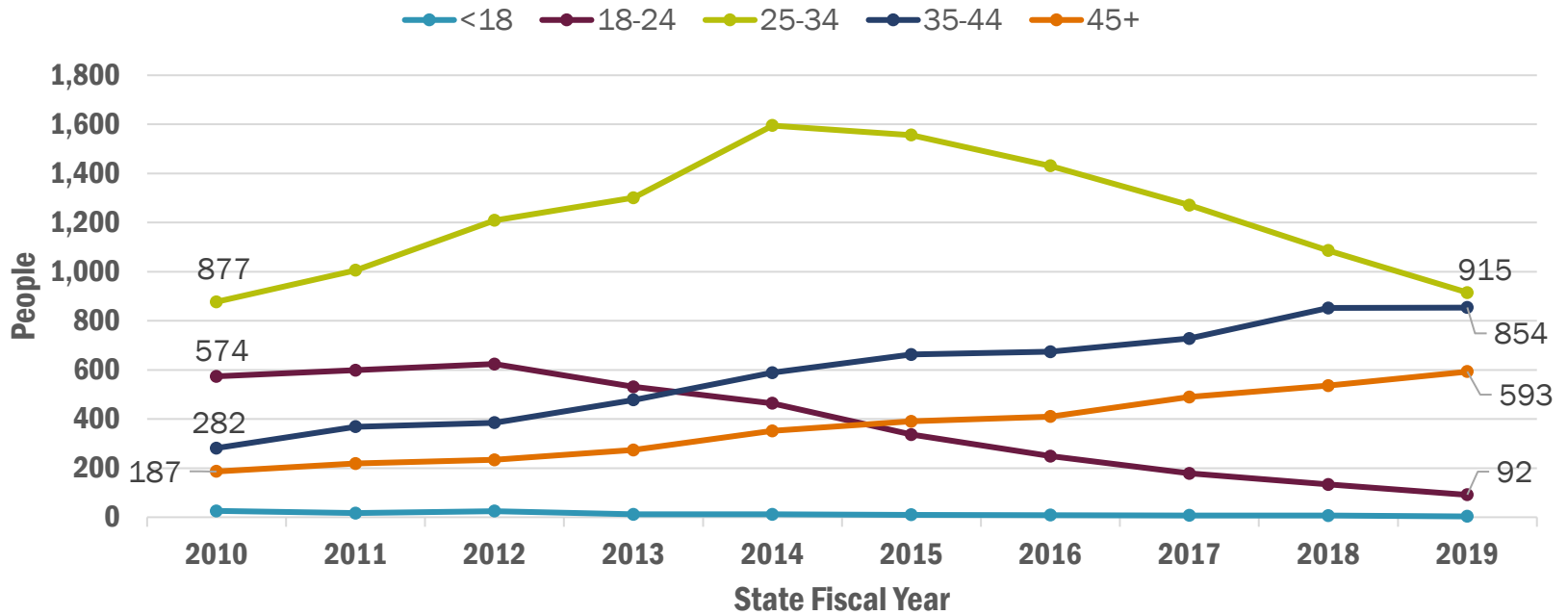
People Treated for Heroin Use Disorder by Age and Fiscal Year

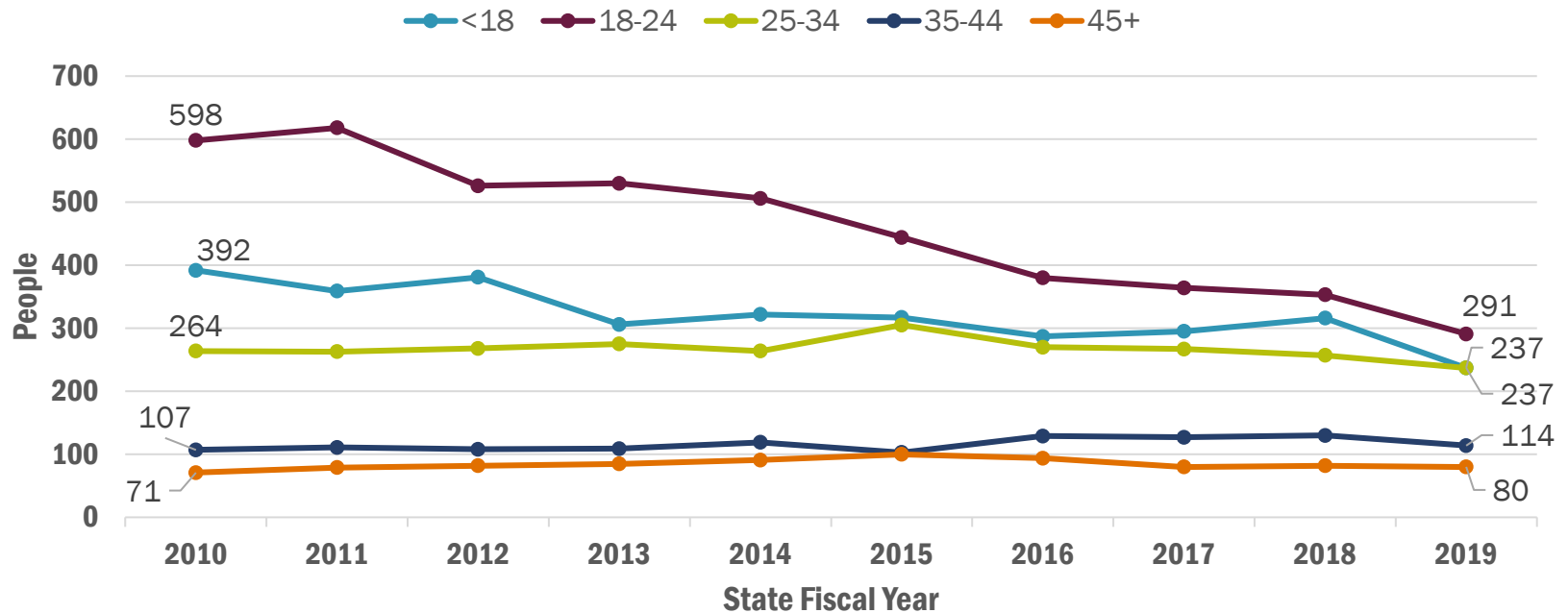
People Treated for Other Opioids and Synthetics Use Disorder by Age and Fiscal Year

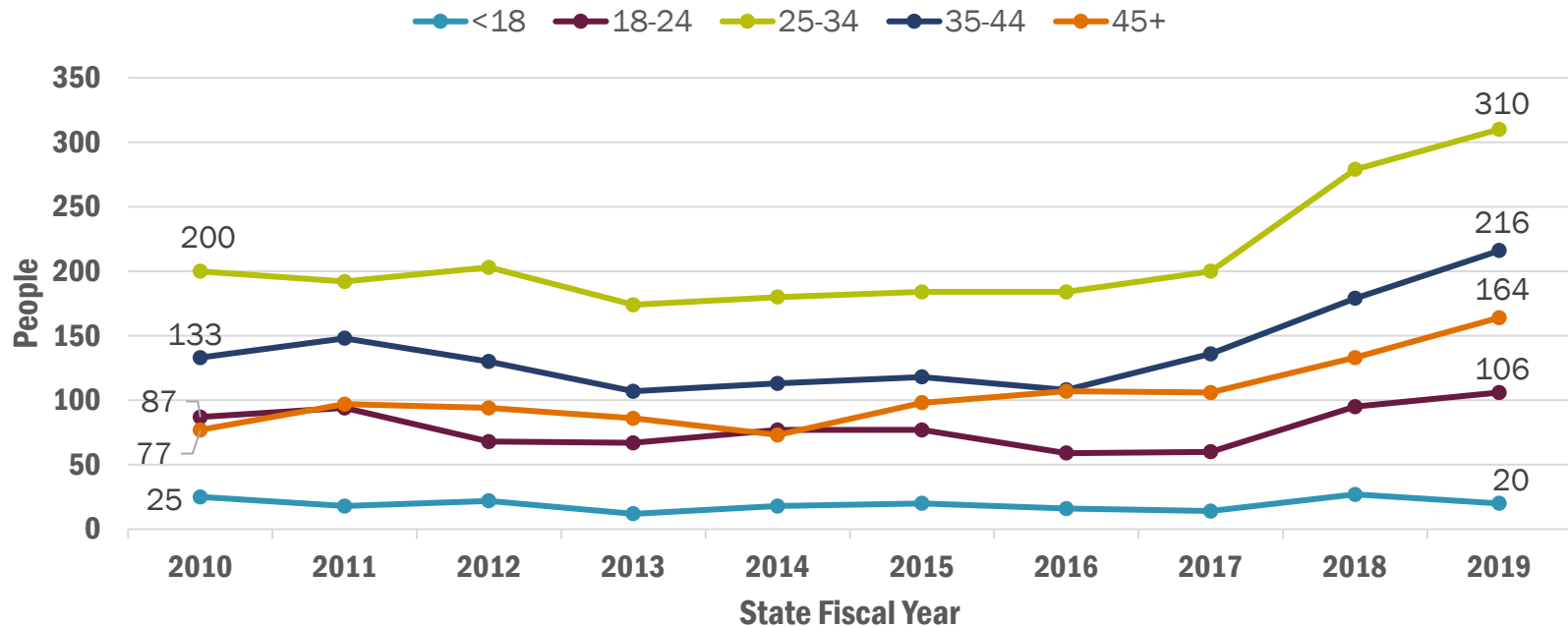
People Treated for Marijuana/Hashish Use Disorder by Age and Fiscal Year

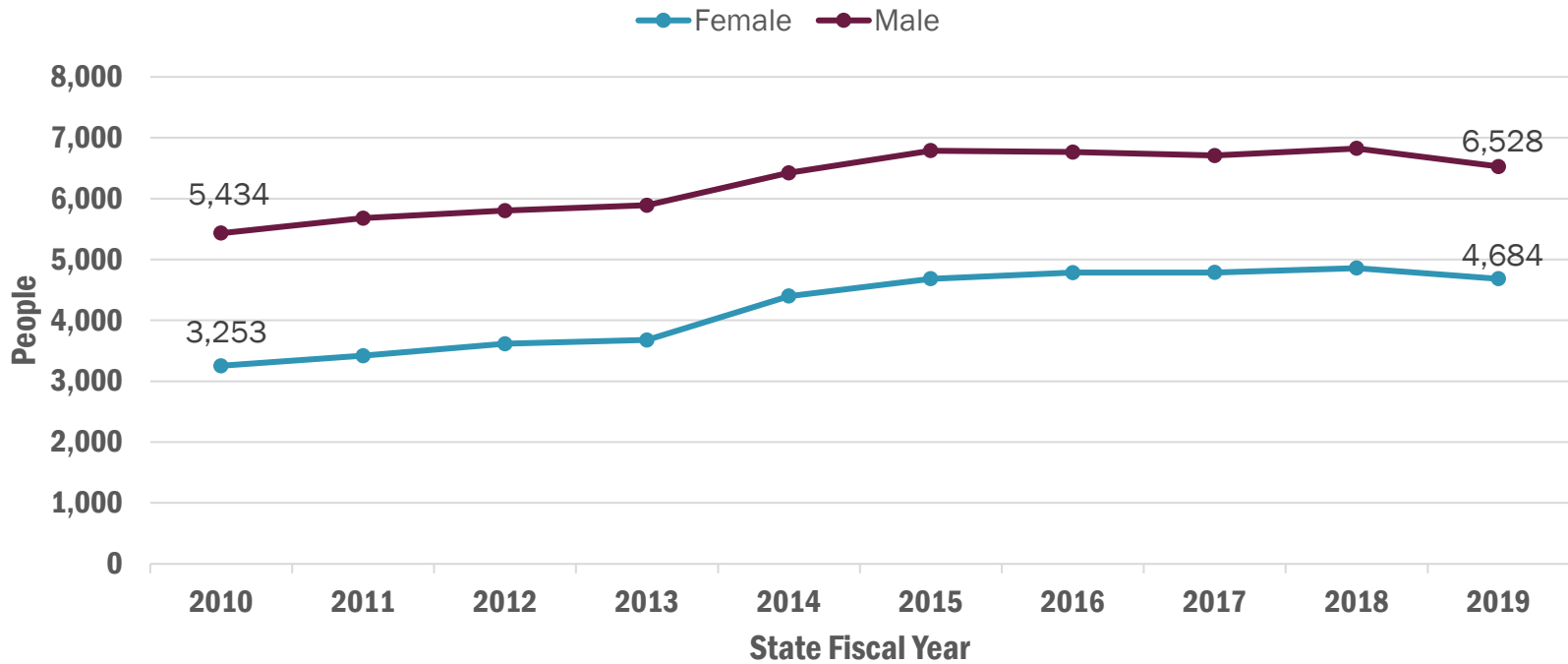
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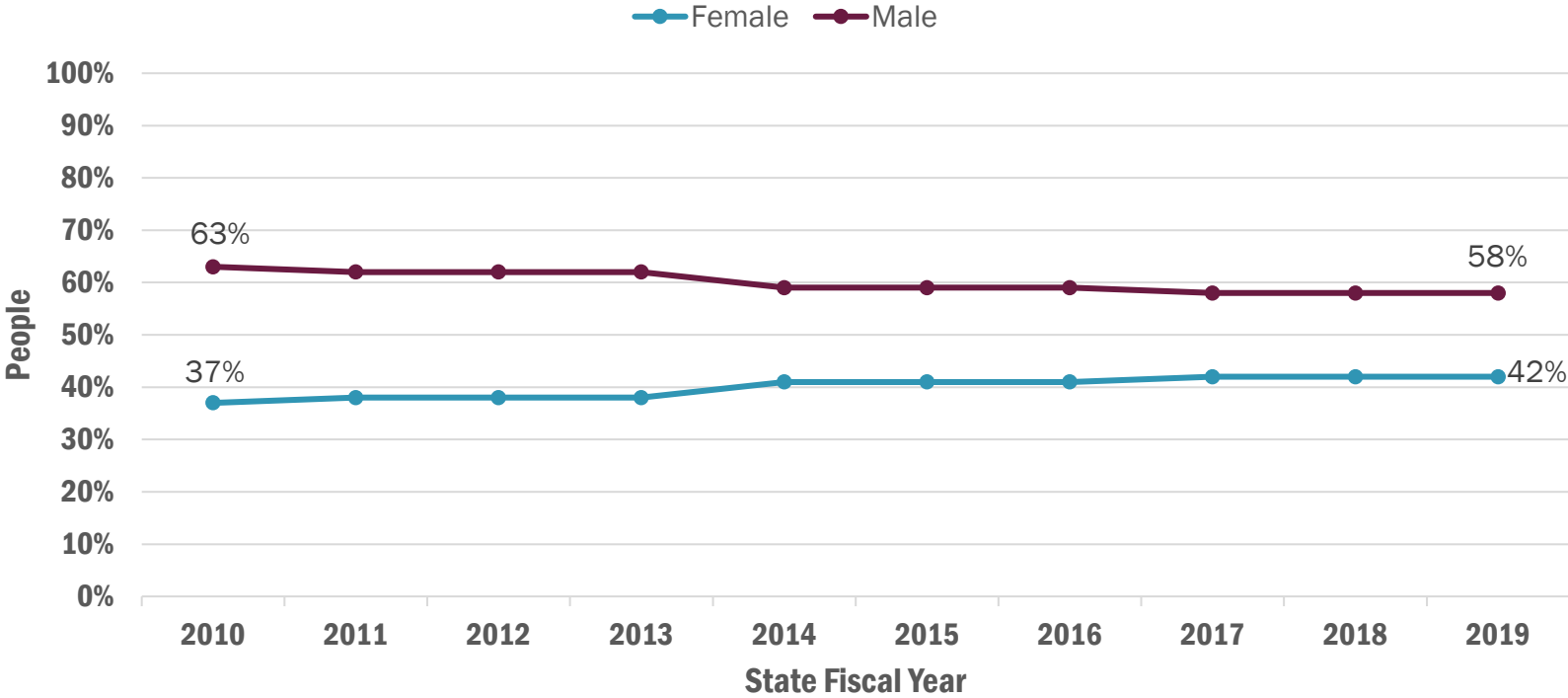
People Treated for Substance Use Disorder by Gender and Fiscal Year

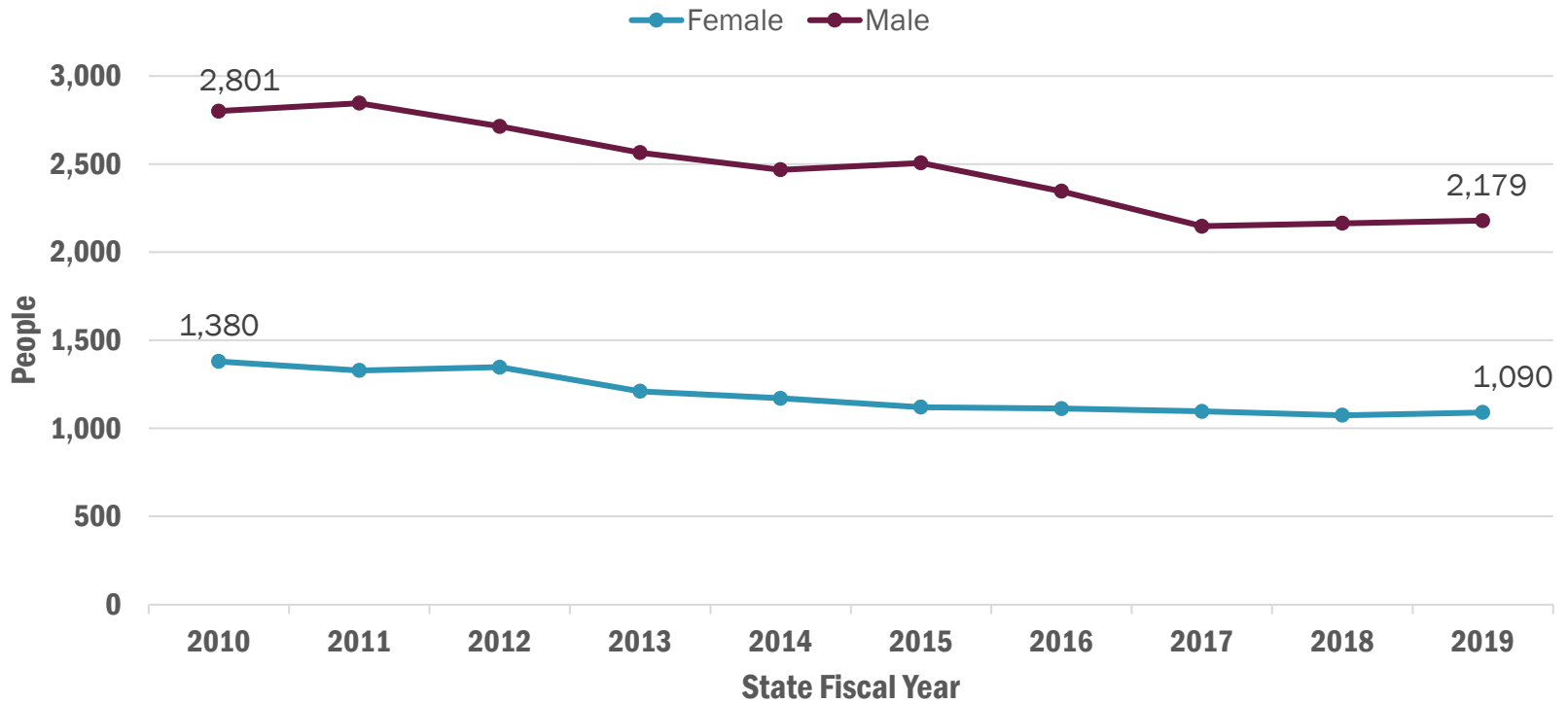
People Treated for Substance Use Disorder by Gender and Fiscal Year by Percent of Treatment Population

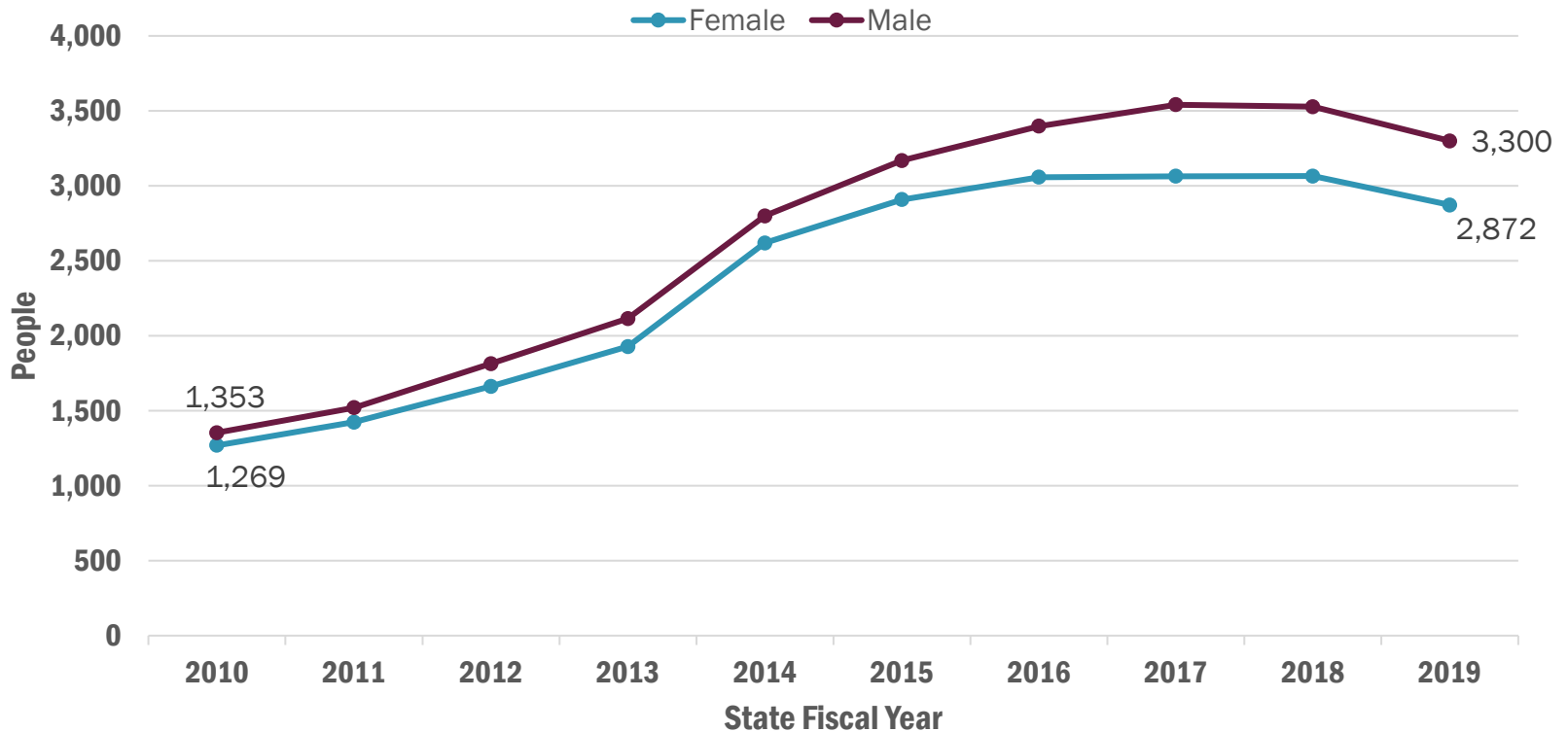
People Treated for Alcohol Use Disorder by Gender and Fiscal Year

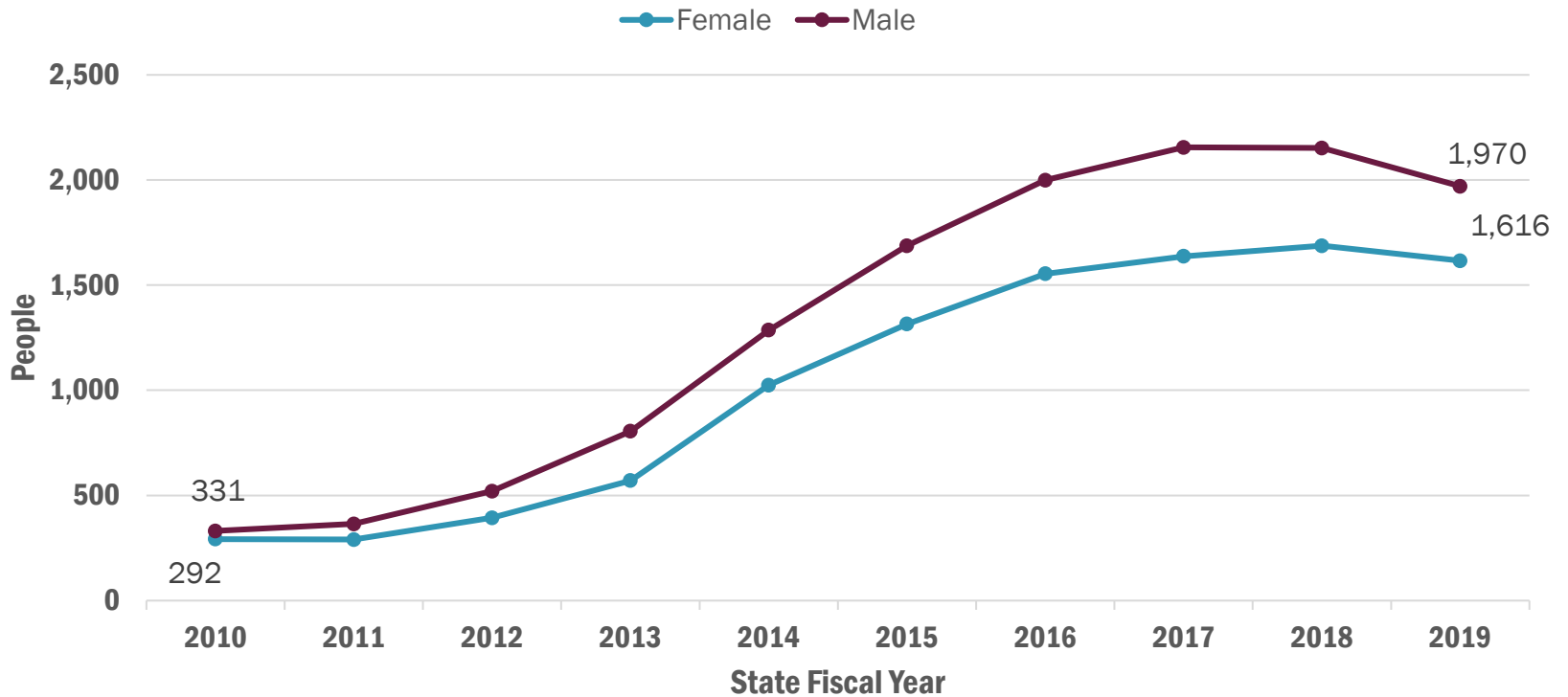
People Treated for All Opioid Use Disorder by Gender and Fiscal Year

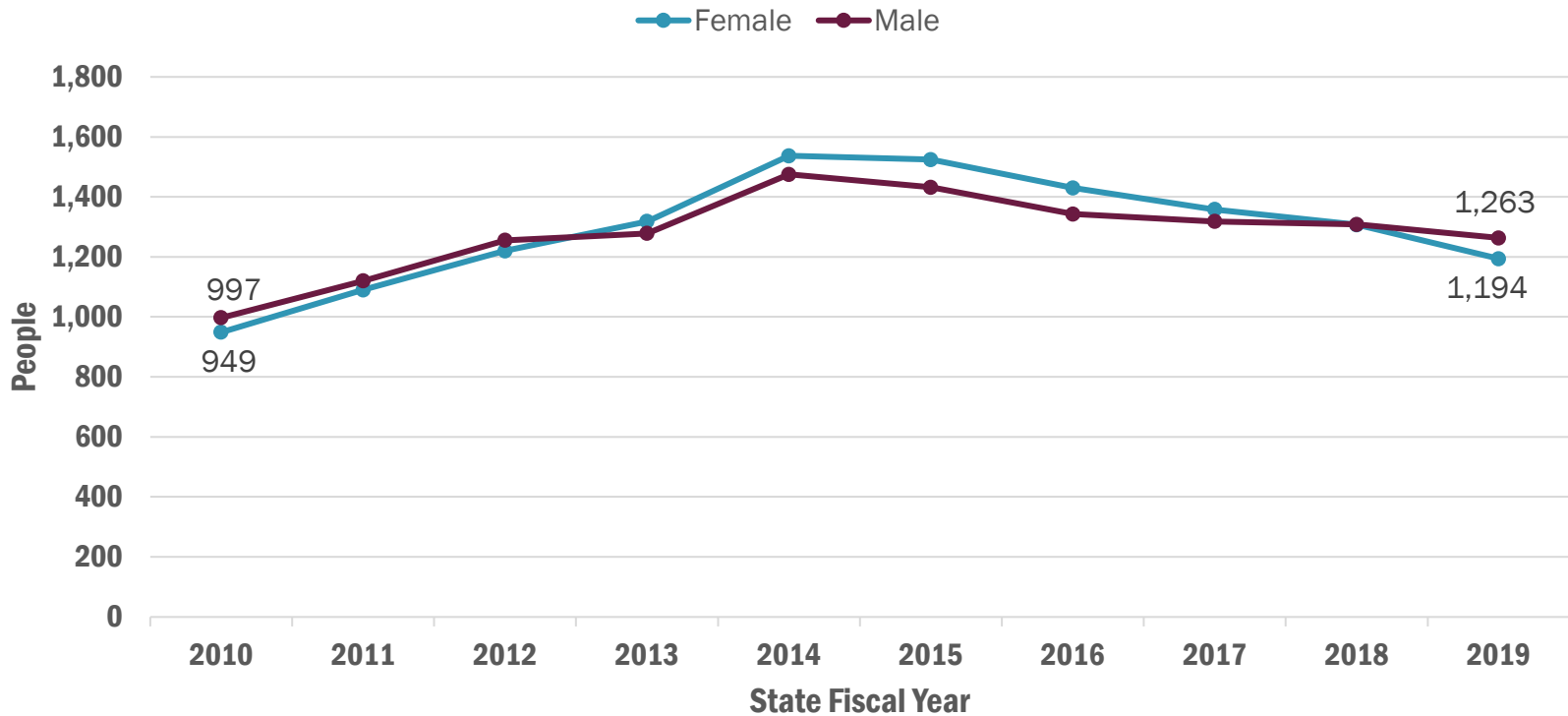
People Treated for Heroin Use Disorder by Gender and Fiscal Year

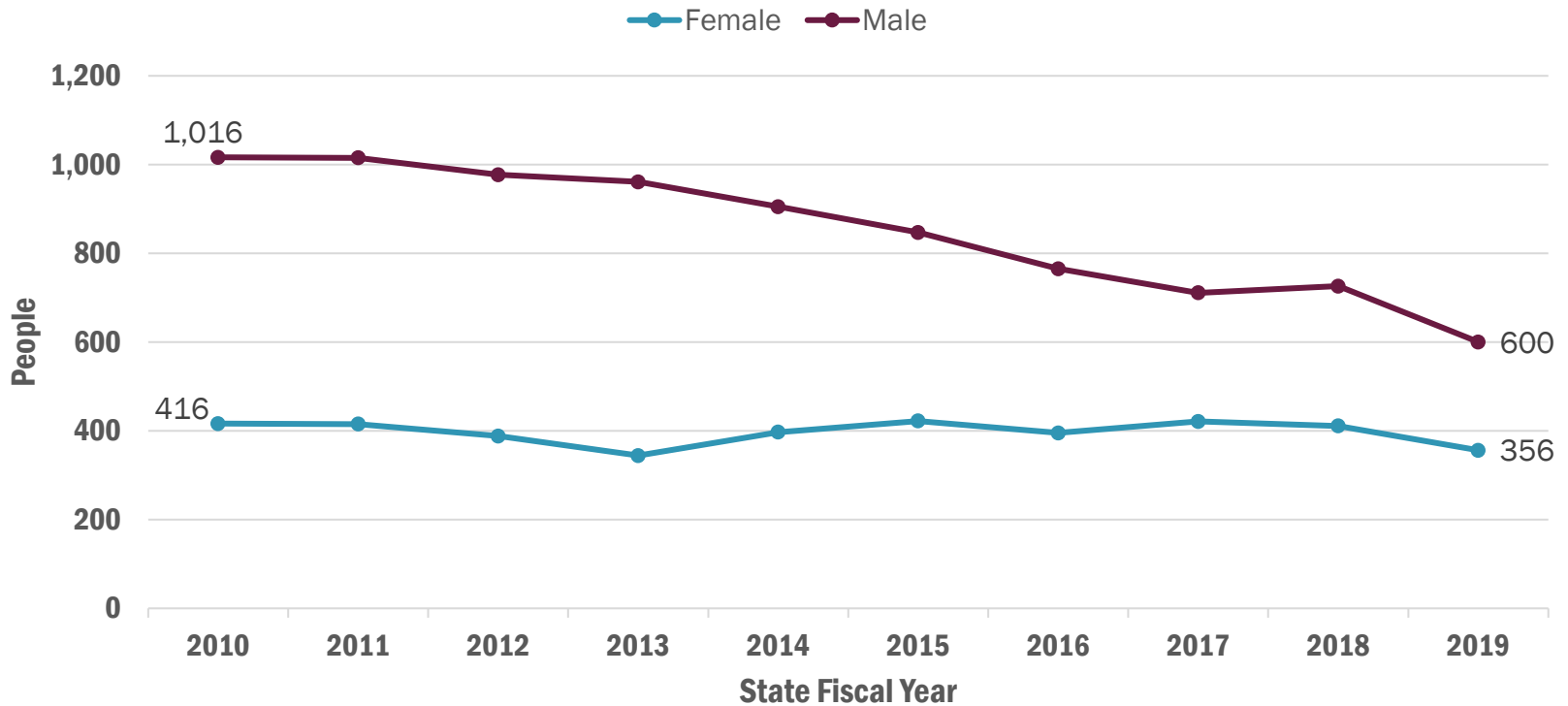
People Treated for Opioid Use Disorder for Other Opioids and Synthetics by Gender and Fiscal Year

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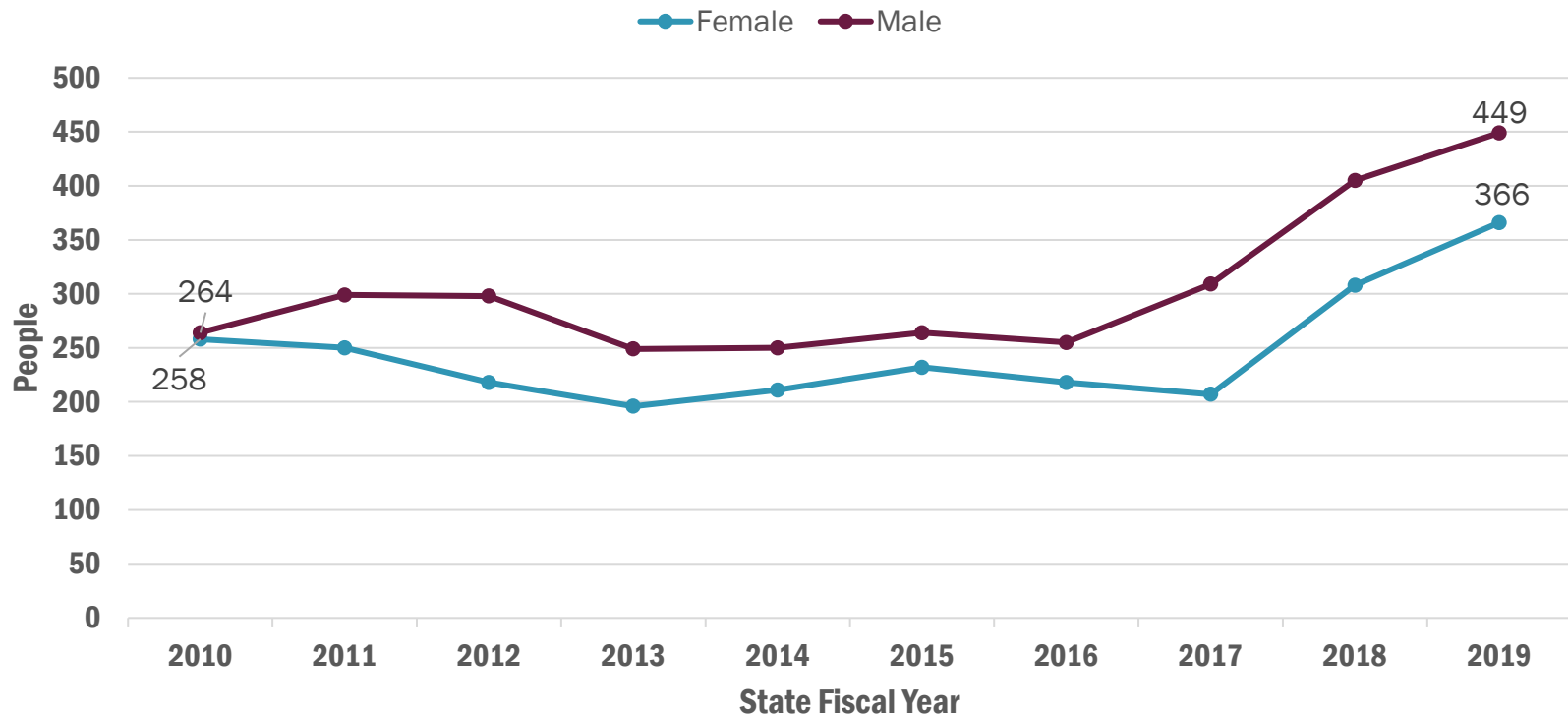
People Treated for Marijuana/Hashish Use Disorder by Gender and Fiscal Year

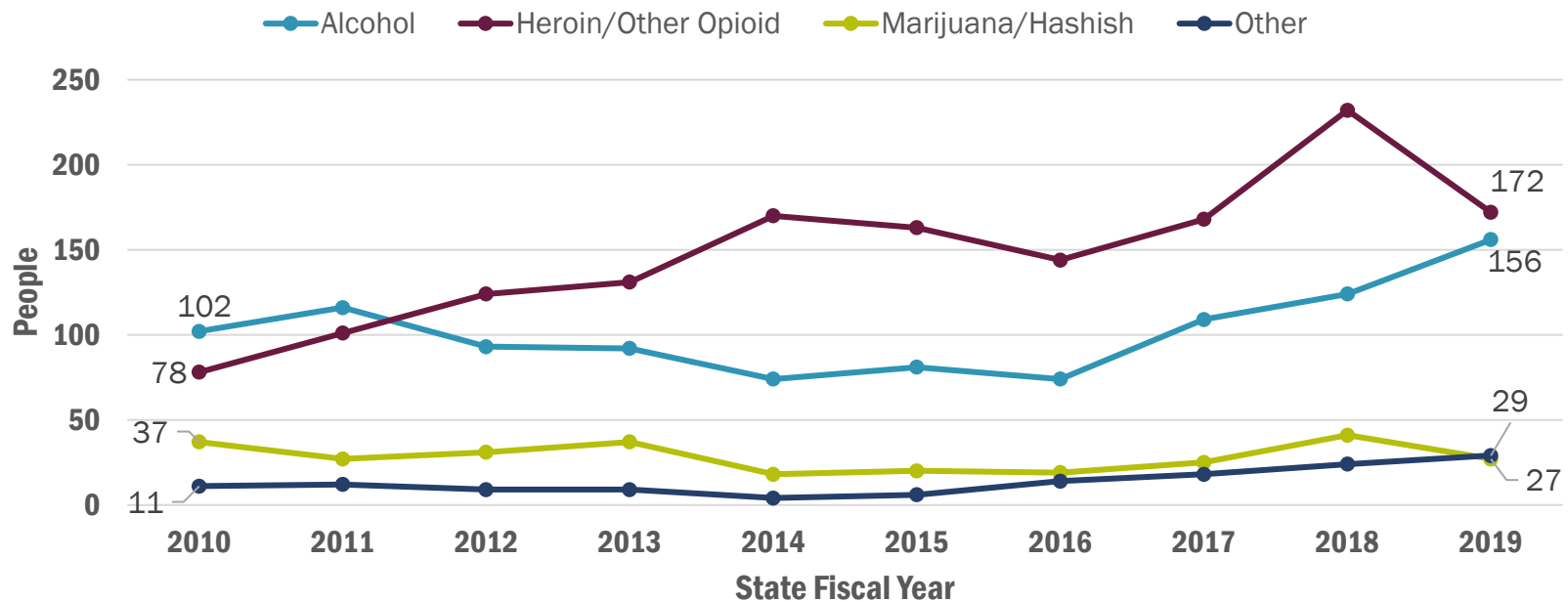

People Treated by COUNTY

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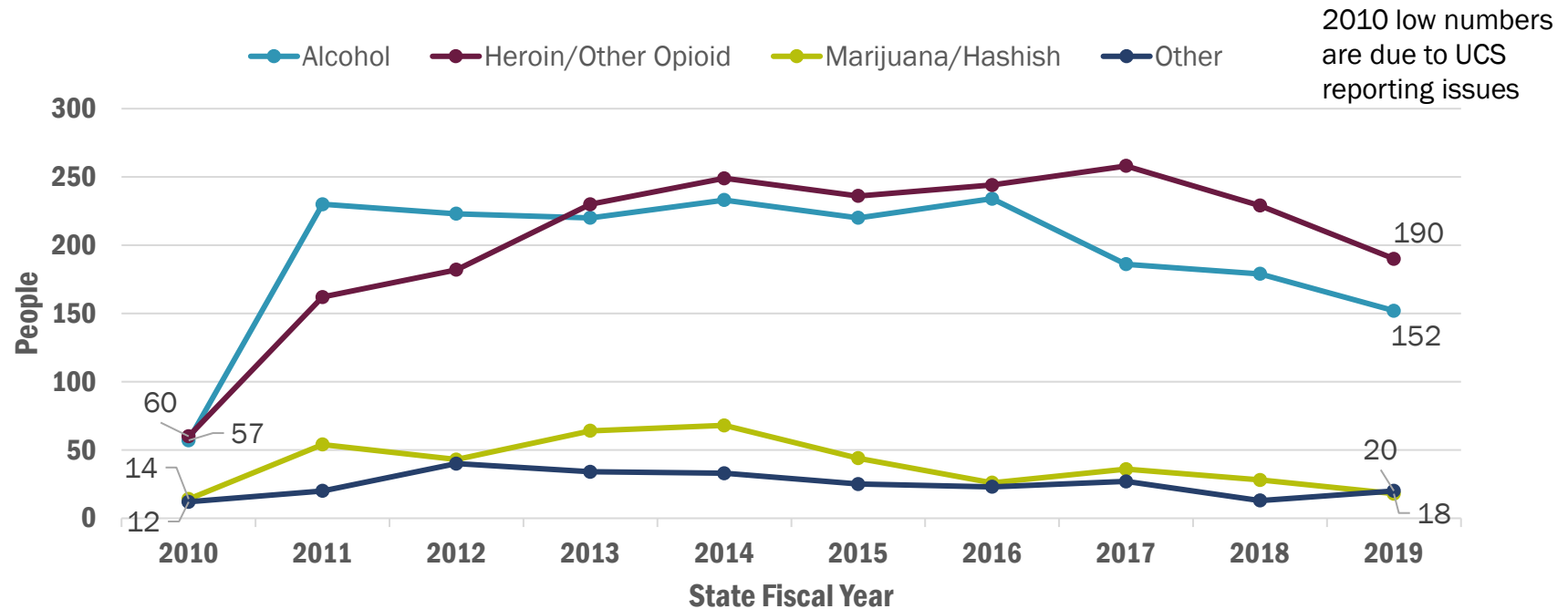
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People Treated by Primary Substance Used and Fiscal Year - Addison County

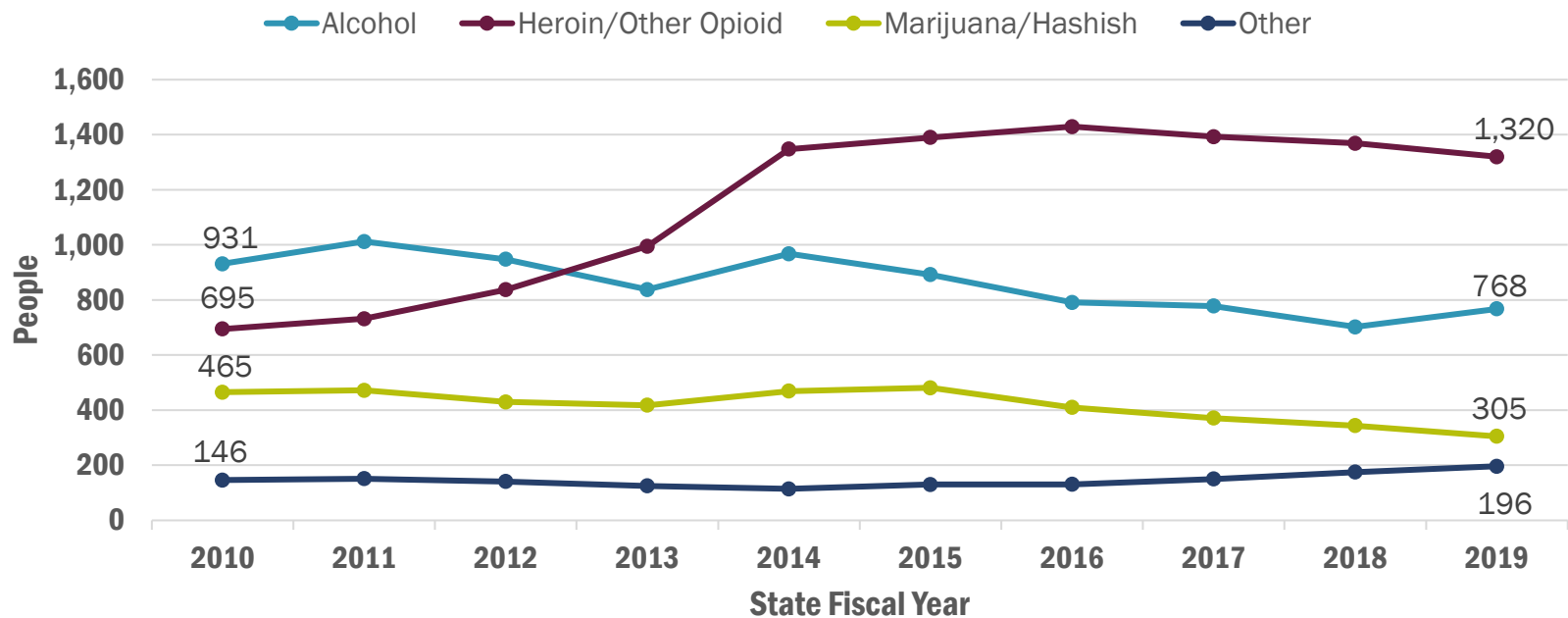
People Treated by Primary Substance Used and Fiscal Year - Bennington County

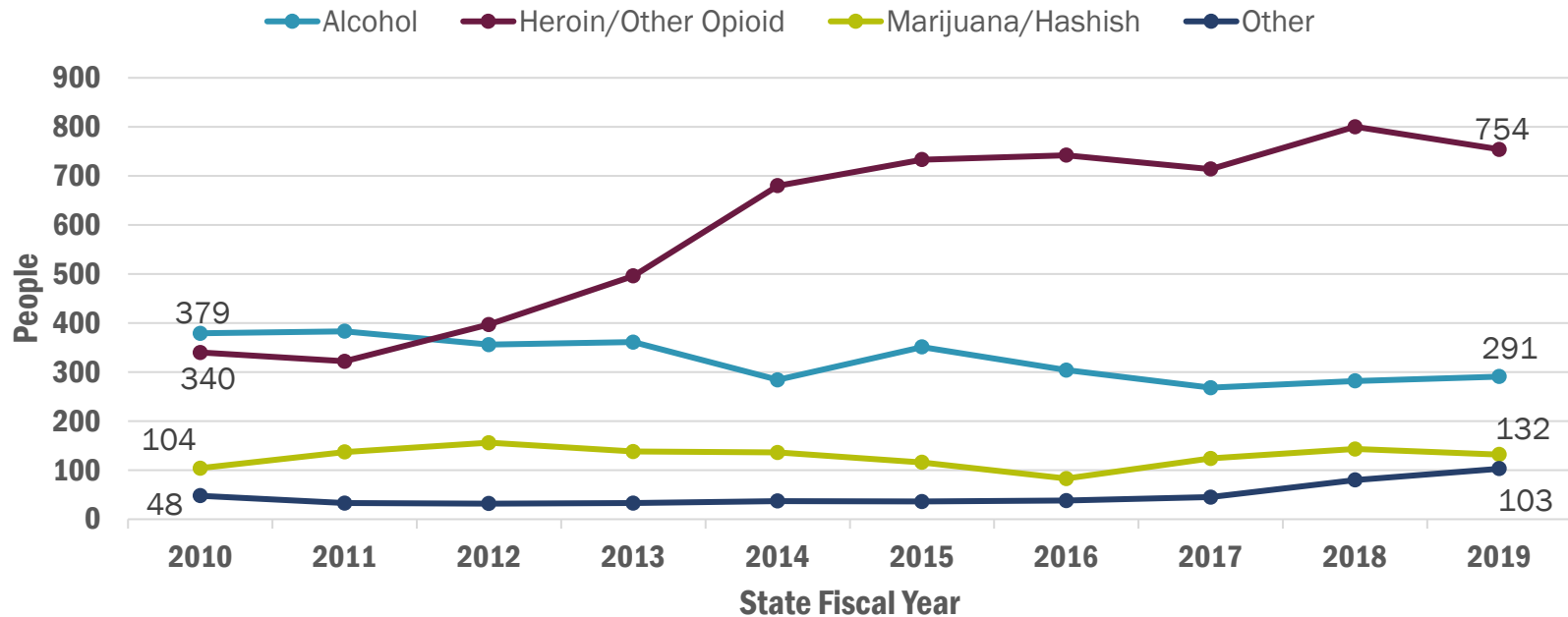
People Treated by Primary Substance Used and Fiscal Year - Chittenden County

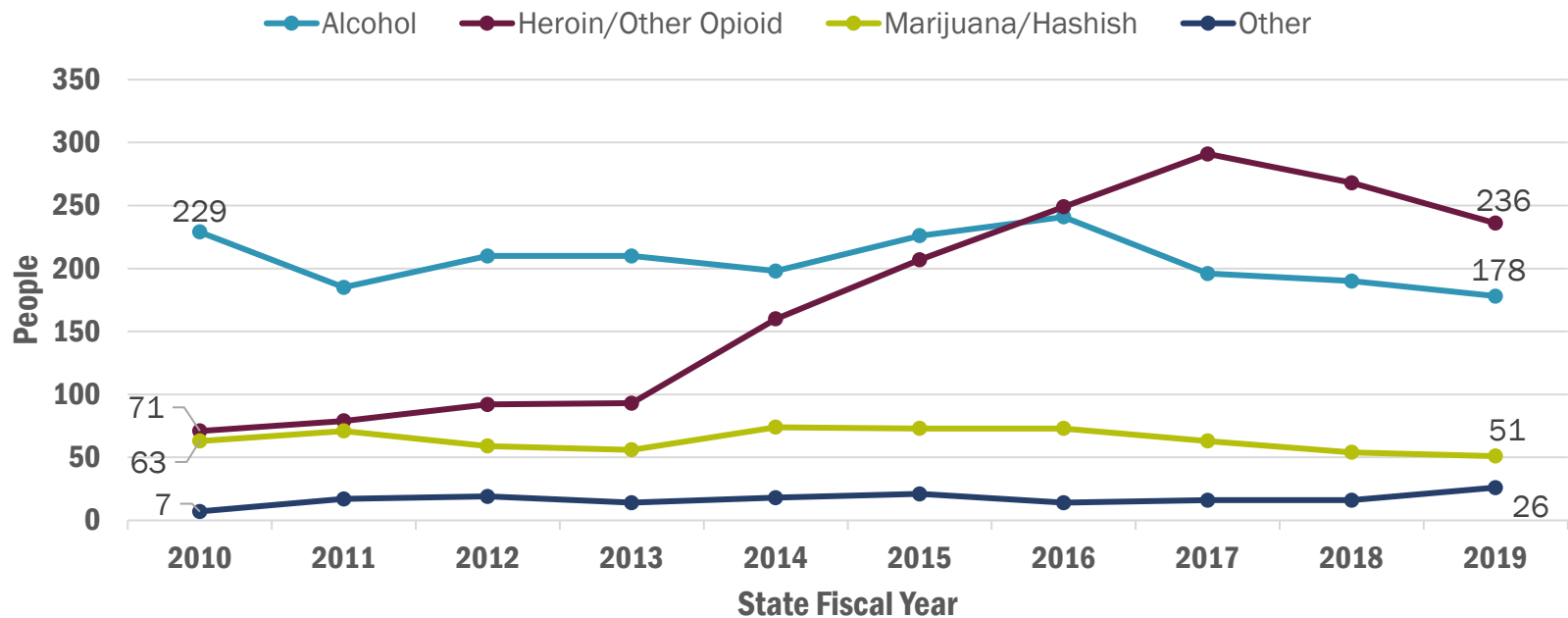

People Treated by Primary Substance Used and Fiscal Year - Franklin and Grand Isle Counties



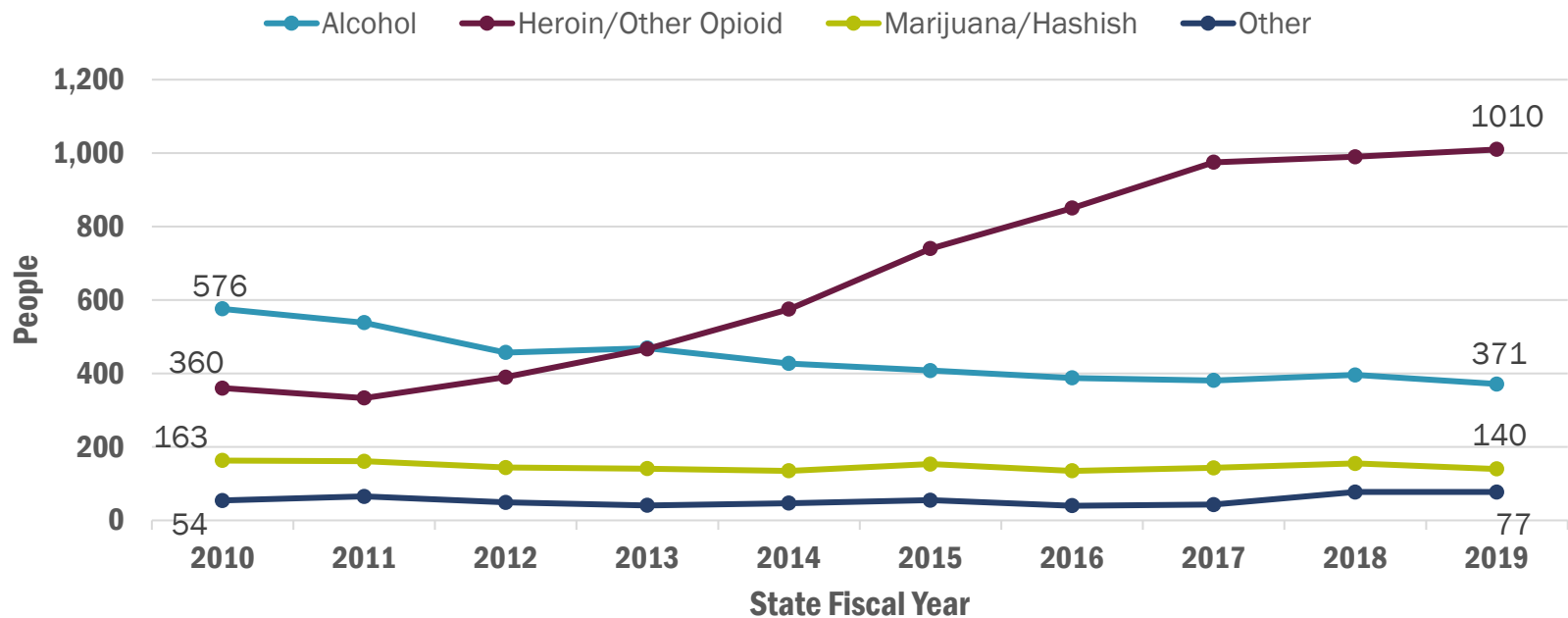

People Treated by Primary Substance Used and Fiscal Year - Lamoille County



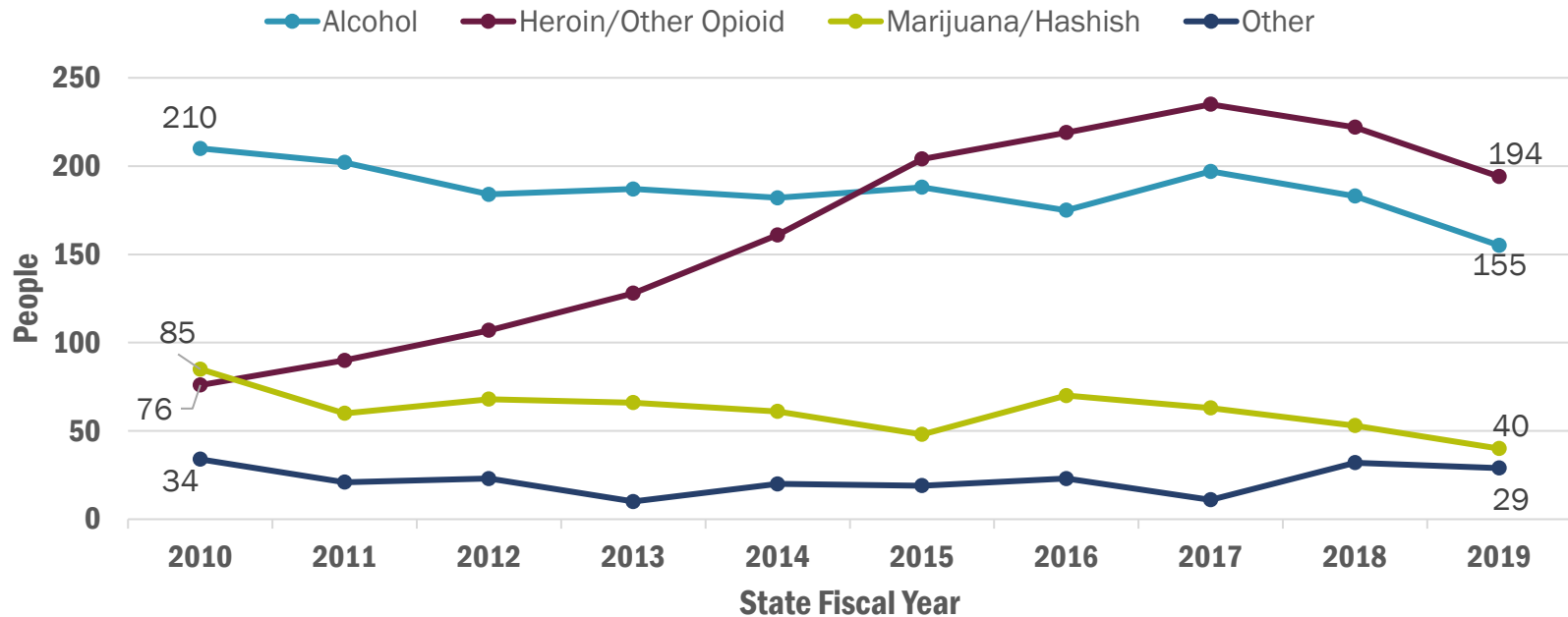

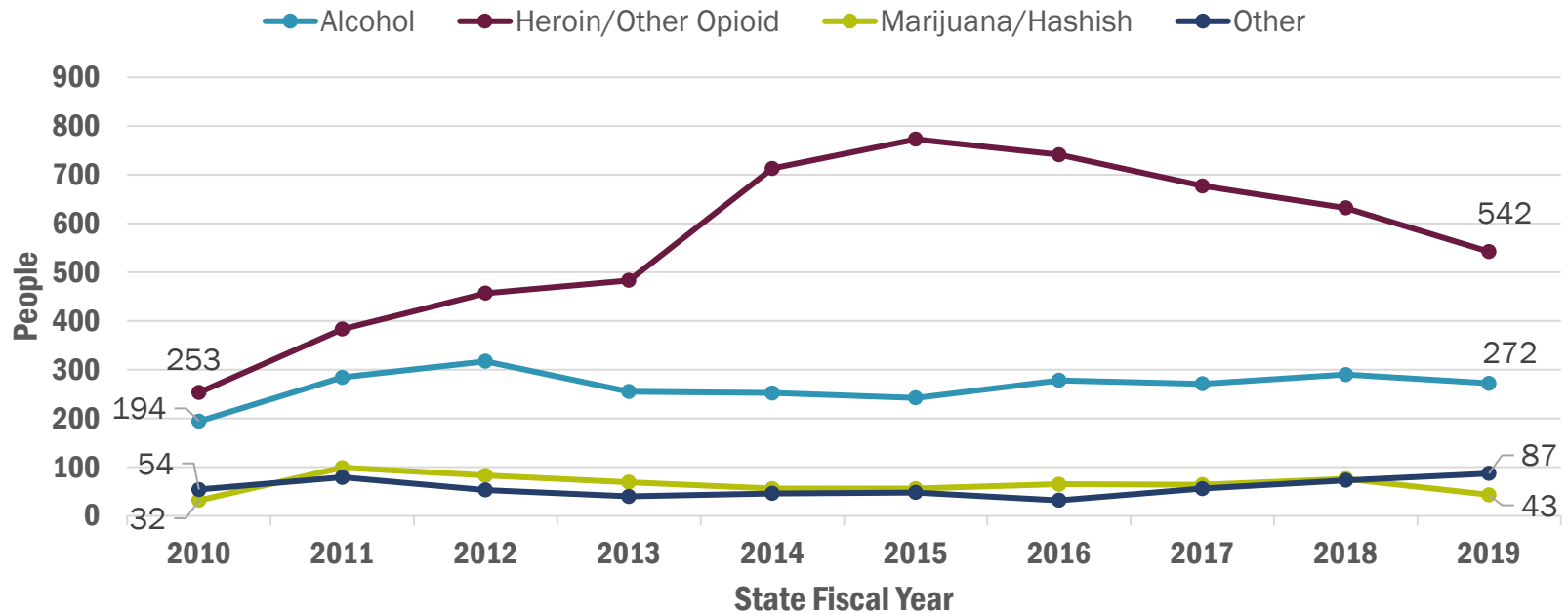
People Treated by Primary Substance Used and Fiscal Year - Orange County

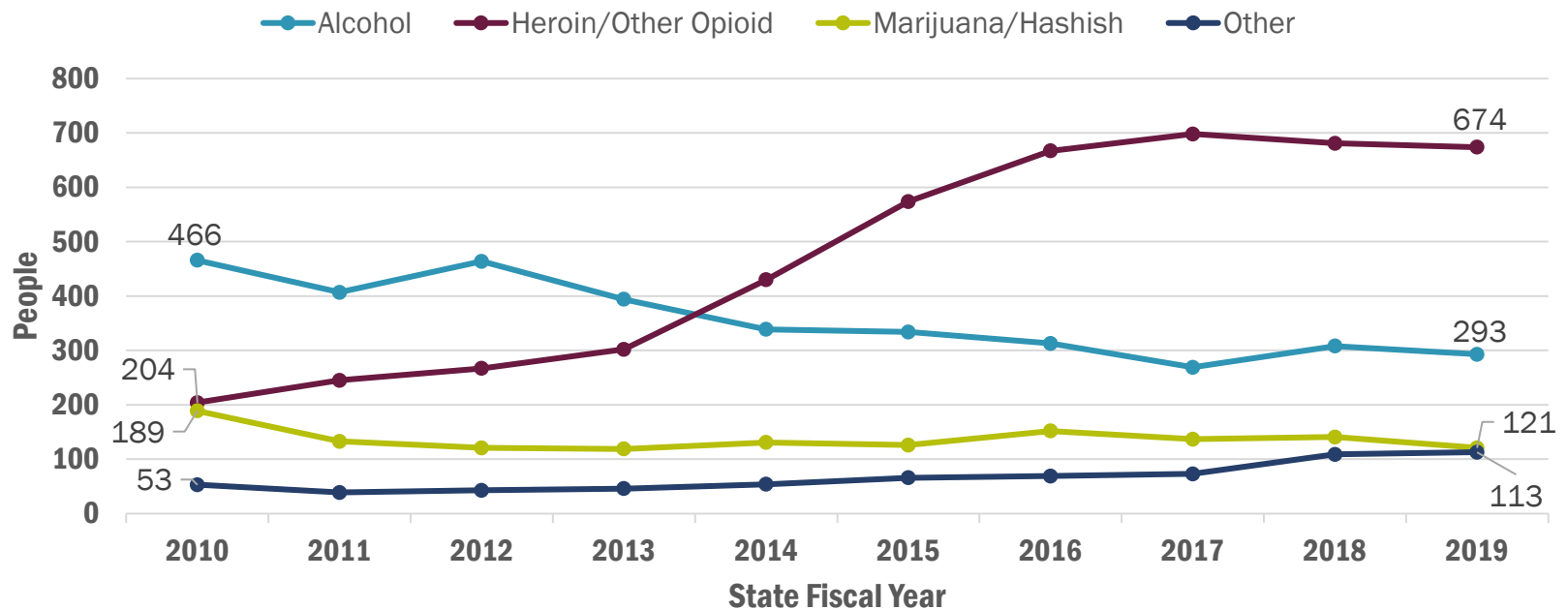
People Treated by Primary Substance Used and Fiscal Year - Rutland County

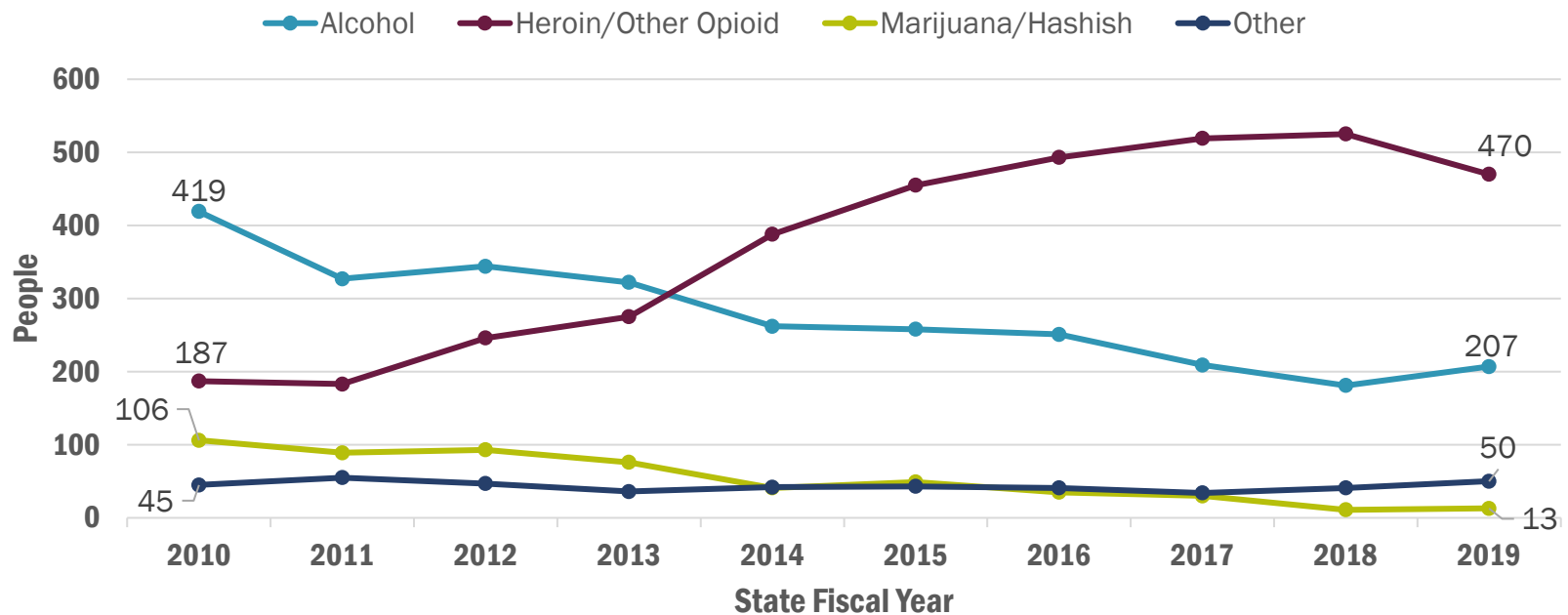
People Treated by Primary Substance Used and Fiscal Year - Washington County

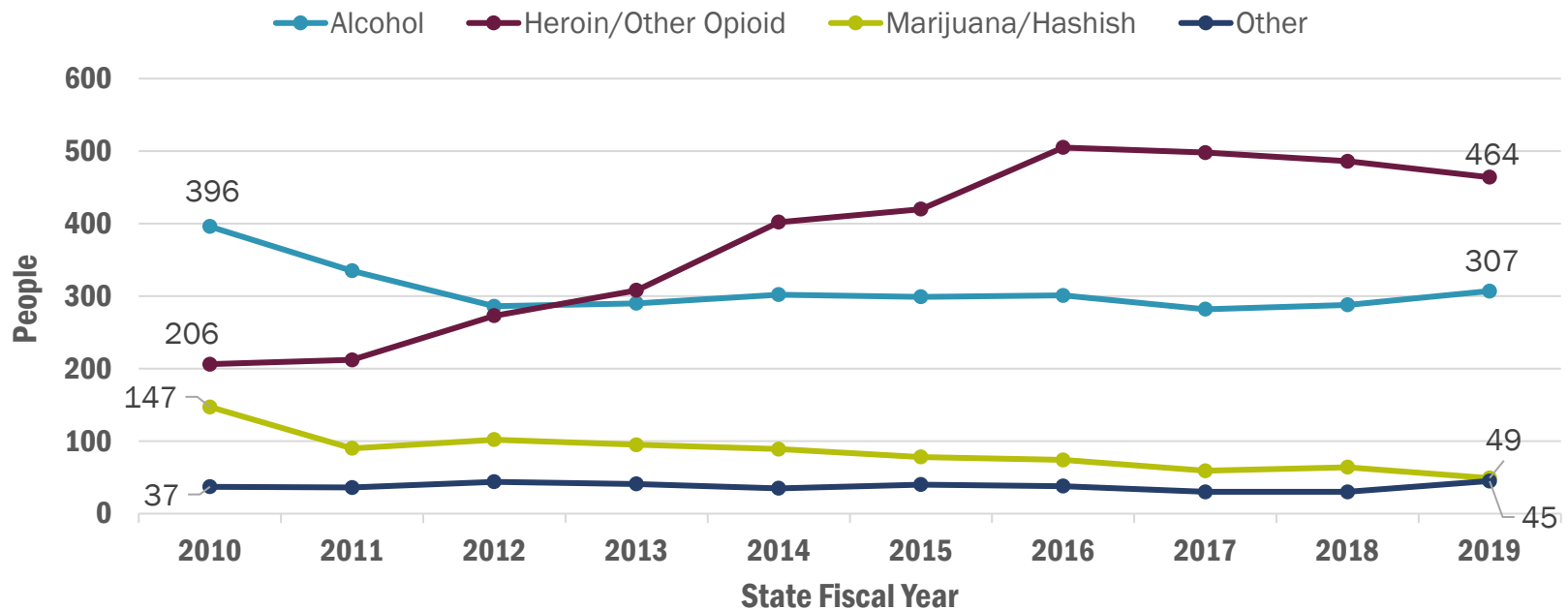
