**ENTRY ORDER**

Respondent's petition for relief from condition #6 of his Stipulation and Consent Order is GRANTED. As of January 4, 2023, Respondent is no longer prohibited from prescribing Schedule II, III, IV, and V controlled substances as defined in 21 C.F.R. § 1308 and may apply for and/or obtain his DEA license to prescribe controlled substances. If Respondent obtains his DEA license, he may only prescribe buprenorphine and shall be permanently prohibited from prescribing any other Schedule II, III, IV, and V controlled substance. Condition #6 of his Stipulation and Consent Order, as amended, shall provide:

“Respondent shall be permanently prohibited from prescribing Schedule II, III, IV, and V controlled substances, as defined in 21 C.F.R. § 1308, other than buprenorphine. At no time shall Respondent request or otherwise seek to amend this Stipulation and Consent Order to authorize him to prescribe any other Schedule II, III, IV, and V controlled substance.”

Therefore, this Order is issued and entered by the Board of Medical Practice to amend condition #6 and its requirements imposed by the Stipulation and Consent Order of May 1, 2019.
