**NOTICE OF ENTRY ORDER**

Please take notice that an Order was issued and entered by the Vermont Board of Medical Practice on October 1, 2014, approving Respondent's Petition to Modify Stipulation and Consent Order.

The Stipulation and Consent Order dated November 30, 2009, is modified as follows:

1. The conditions on Respondent's license to practice medicine in paragraphs 41 and 42 of the Stipulation and Consent Order are modified to the extent that he may refill prescriptions for DEA Schedule II or III pain medications for up to 30 days and refill those prescriptions with a drug that is clinically equivalent to that originally prescribed.
2. Respondent is relieved from the condition in paragraph 48 of the Stipulation and Consent Order requiring Respondent to maintain a separate file of photocopies of each prescription written by him for DEA Schedule II or III pain medications.
3. Respondent is relieved from the condition in paragraph 30 of the Stipulation and Consent Order requiring Respondent to engage in regular, face-to-face communication with a Supervising Physician.

Other than the modifications listed above, the limitations contained in the Stipulation and Consent Order dated November 30, 2009, shall remain in full force and effect.
