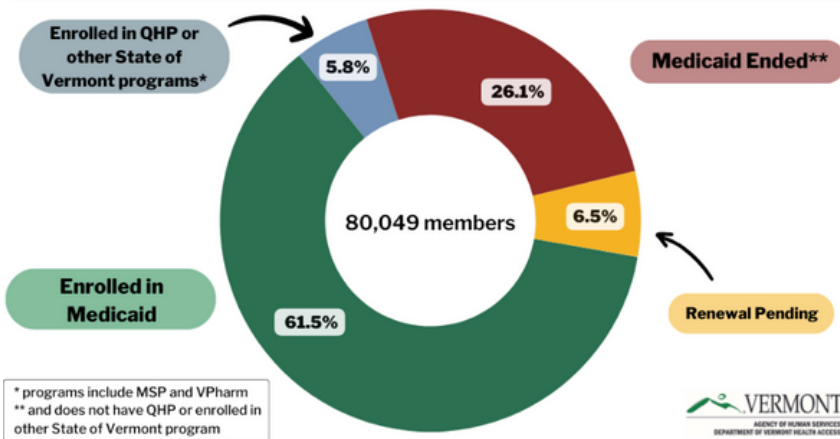
VT MEDICAID RENEWAL DASHBOARD

MOST COMMON REASONS FOR MEDICAID DENIALS

- **No response to mailed notices and renewal form**
- **Incomplete renewal form submitted**
 - * Most common missing information:
 1. Missing income or income is listed with no source
 2. Tax filling status - Filing jointly? Any children tax dependents?
 3. Missing household member(s) information
 - Examples: No date of birth, social security number, or tax filing status, income missing, etc.
- **Renewal complete but no response to income verification request**

IN THE UNITED STATES:

- About 14 million children under 18 years old (19%) have a special healthcare need
- 25% of homes had one or more children with a special healthcare need
- CYSHCN are more likely to live in poverty, be non-Hispanic Black, and have public insurance than non-CYSHCN
- **In Vermont:** Total of all children that are CSHN 15%
