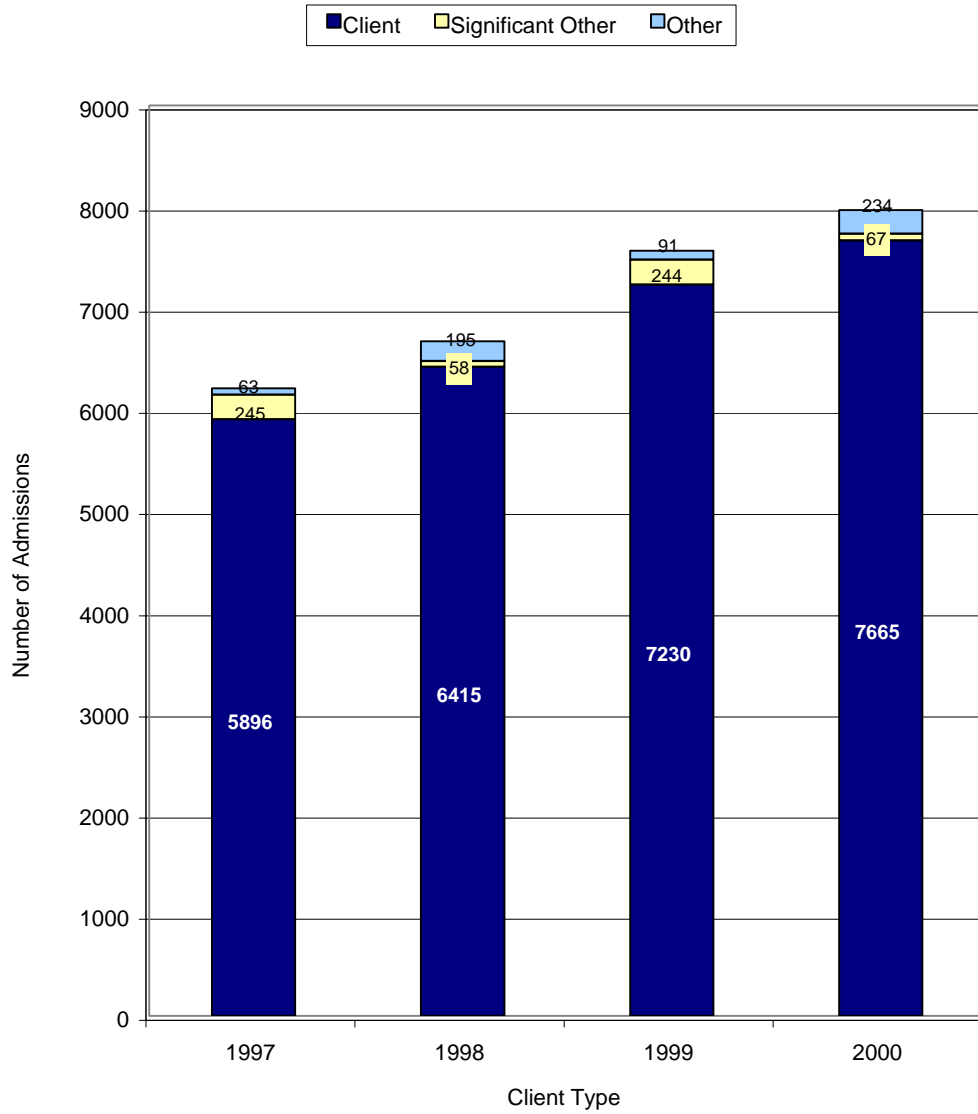

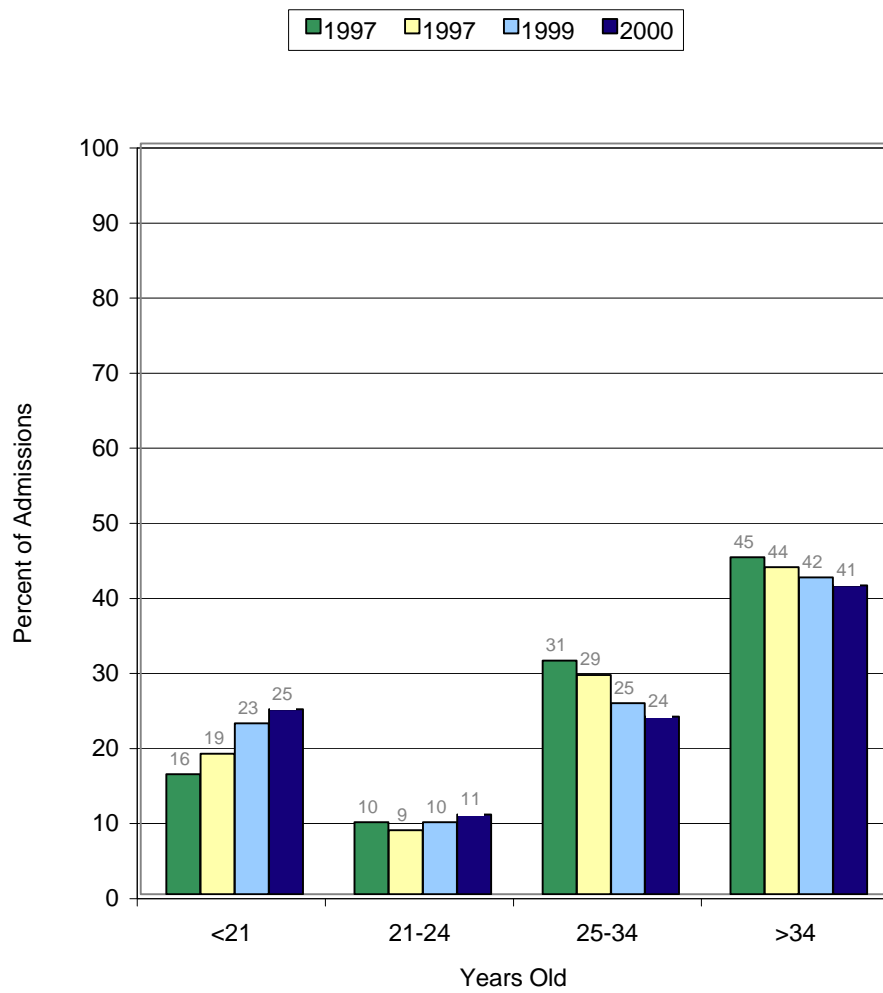

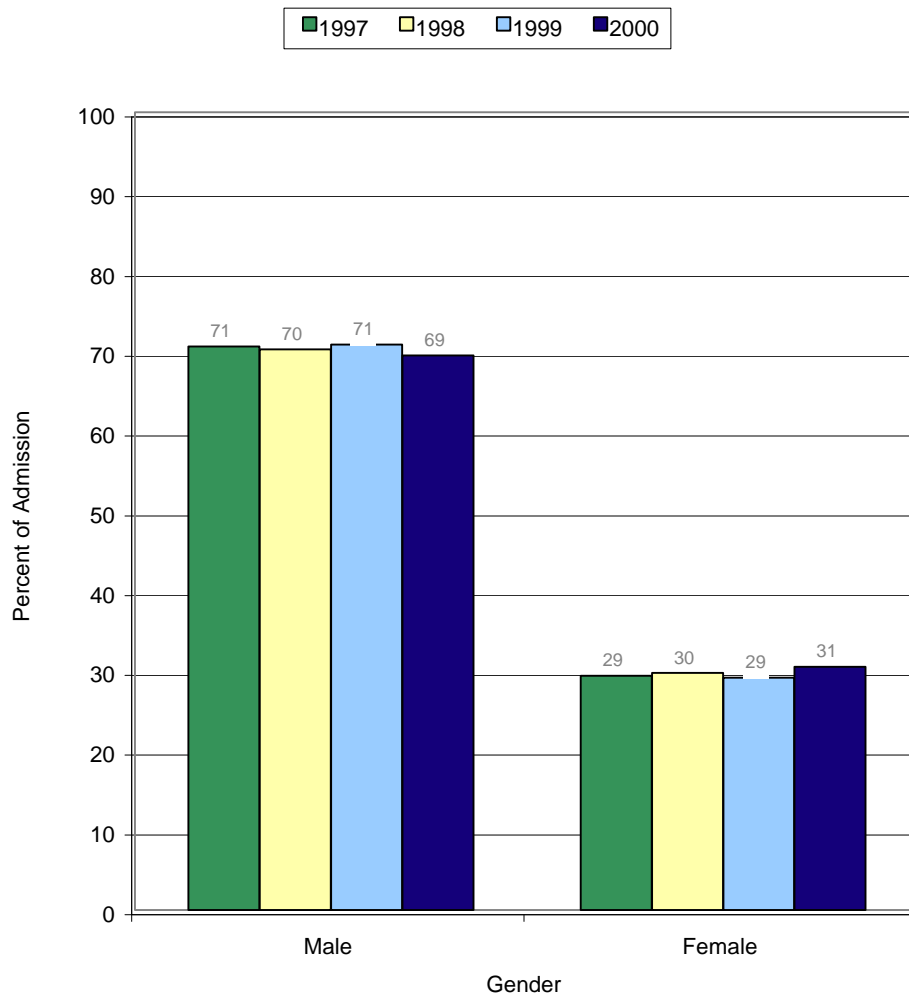

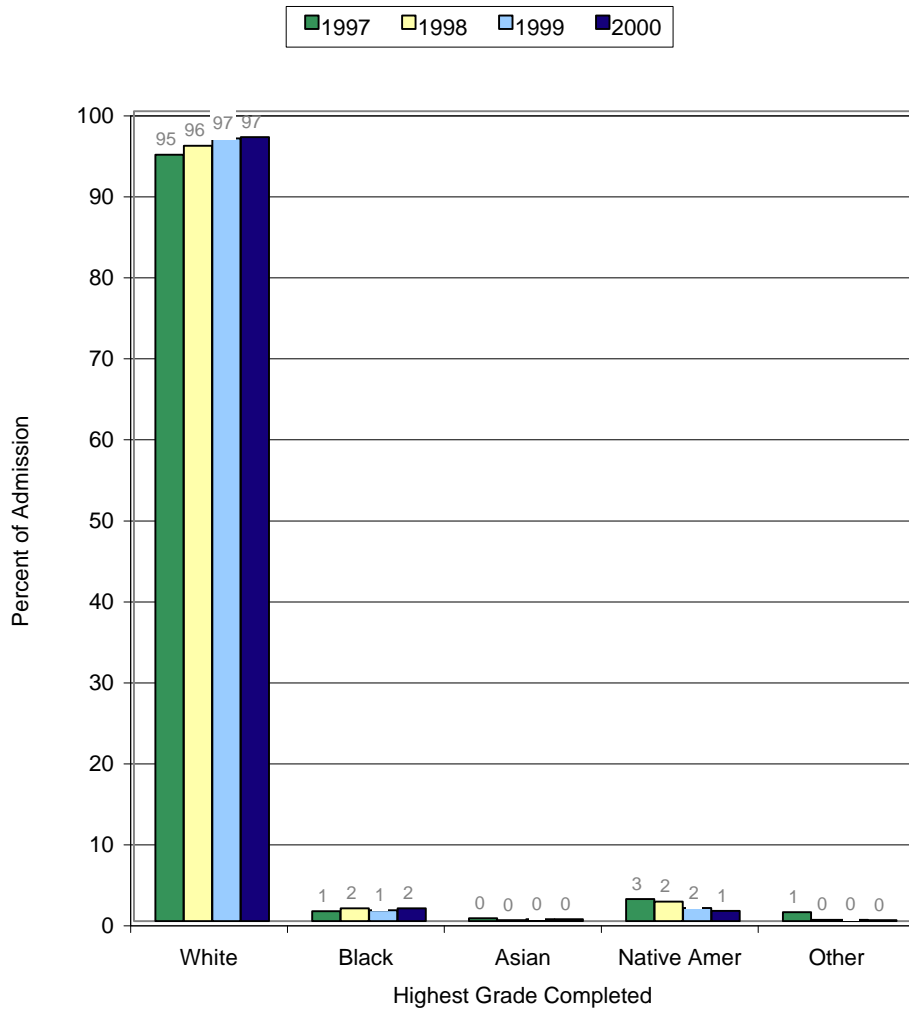

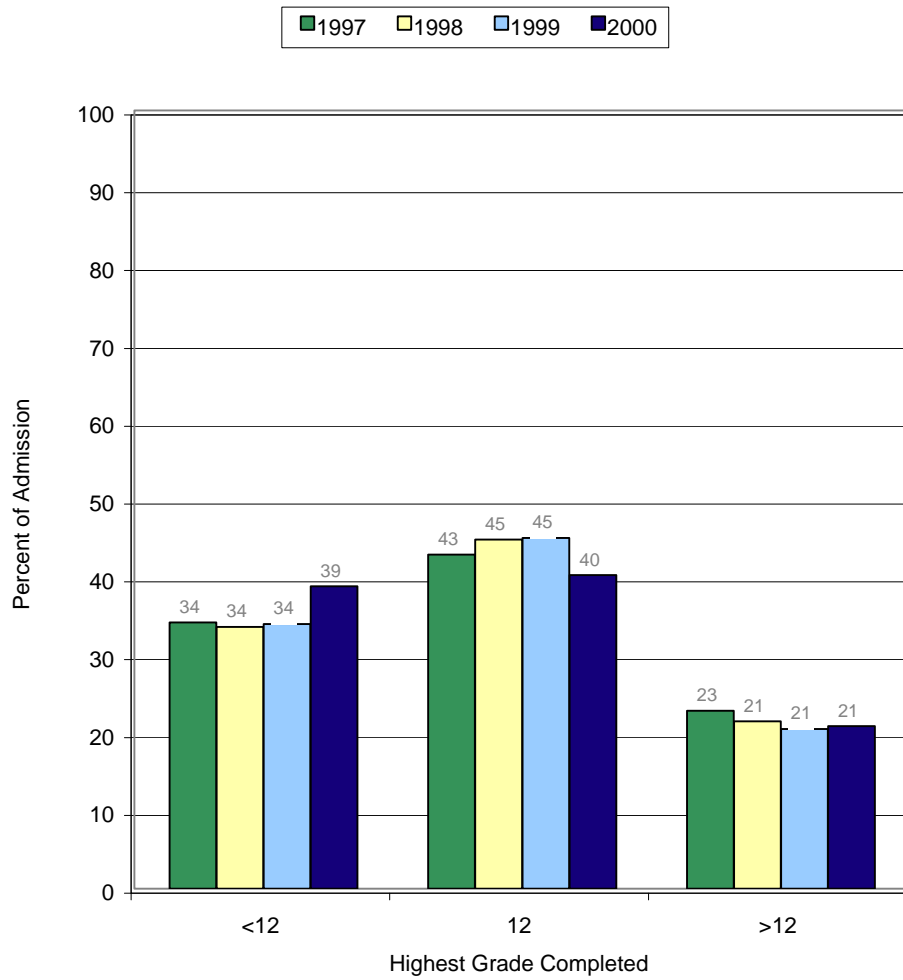

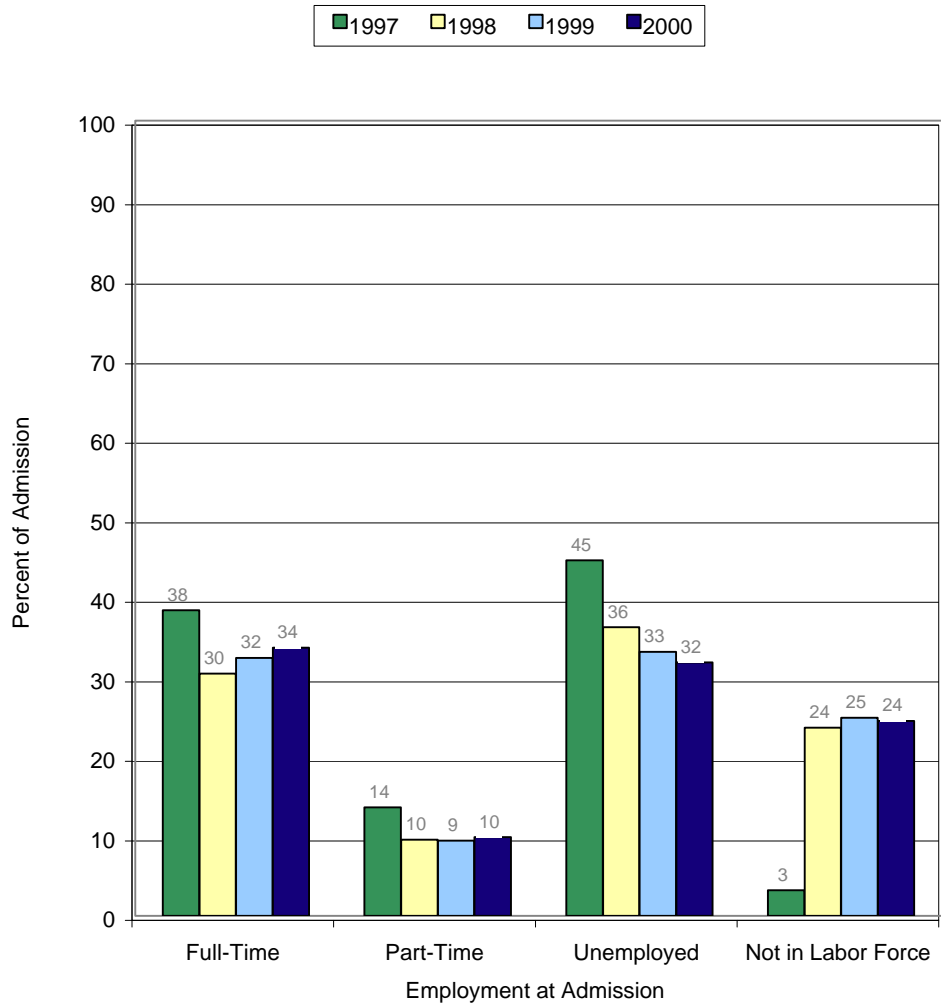

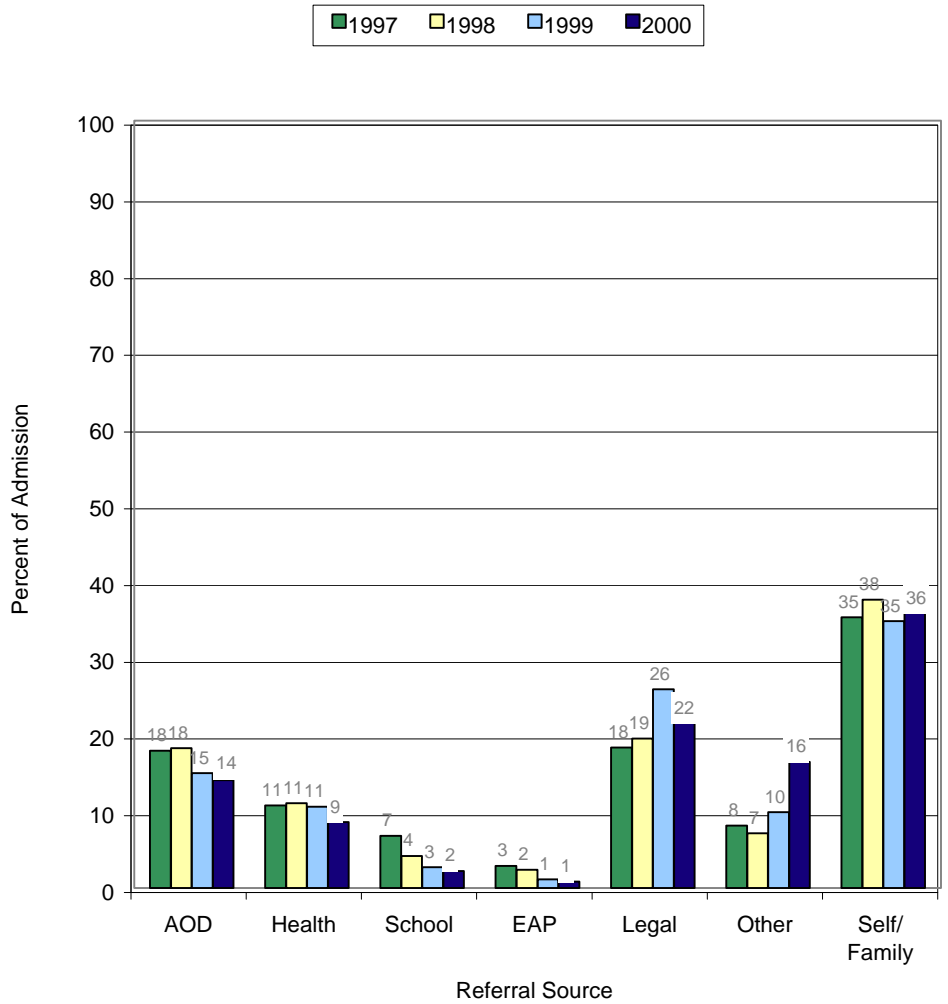

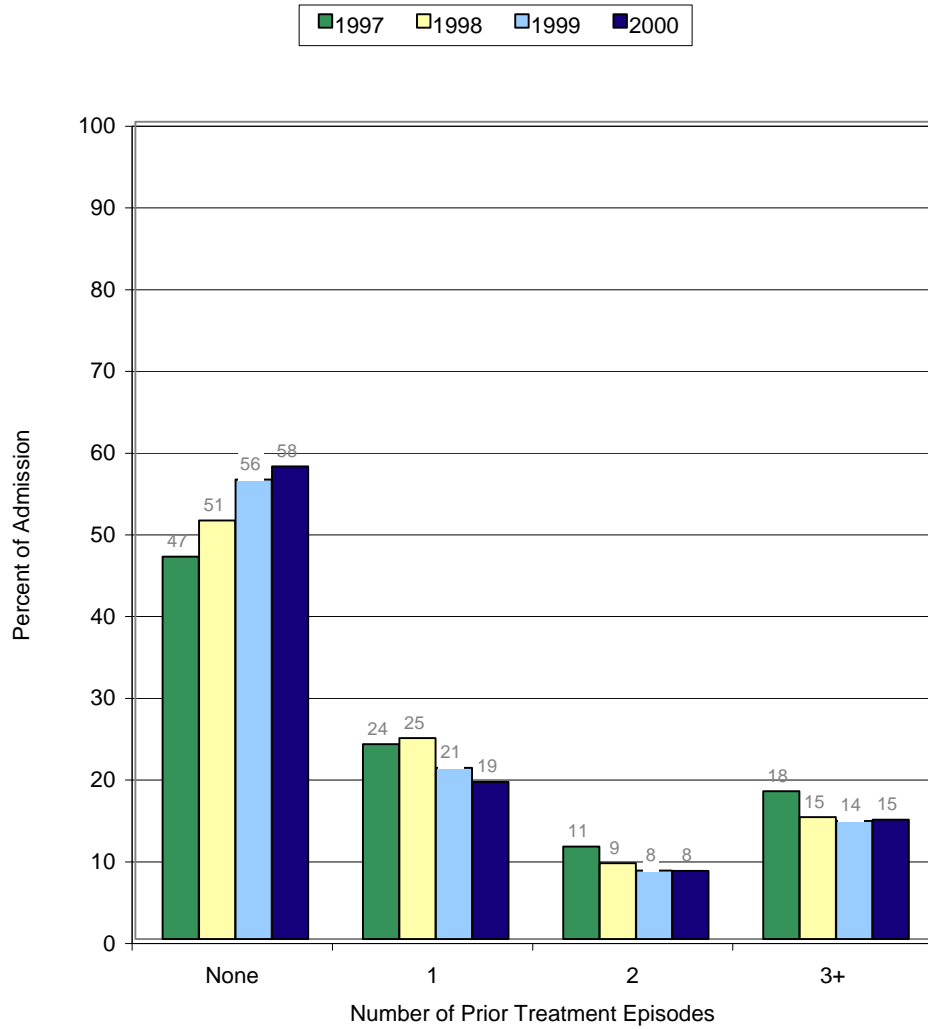

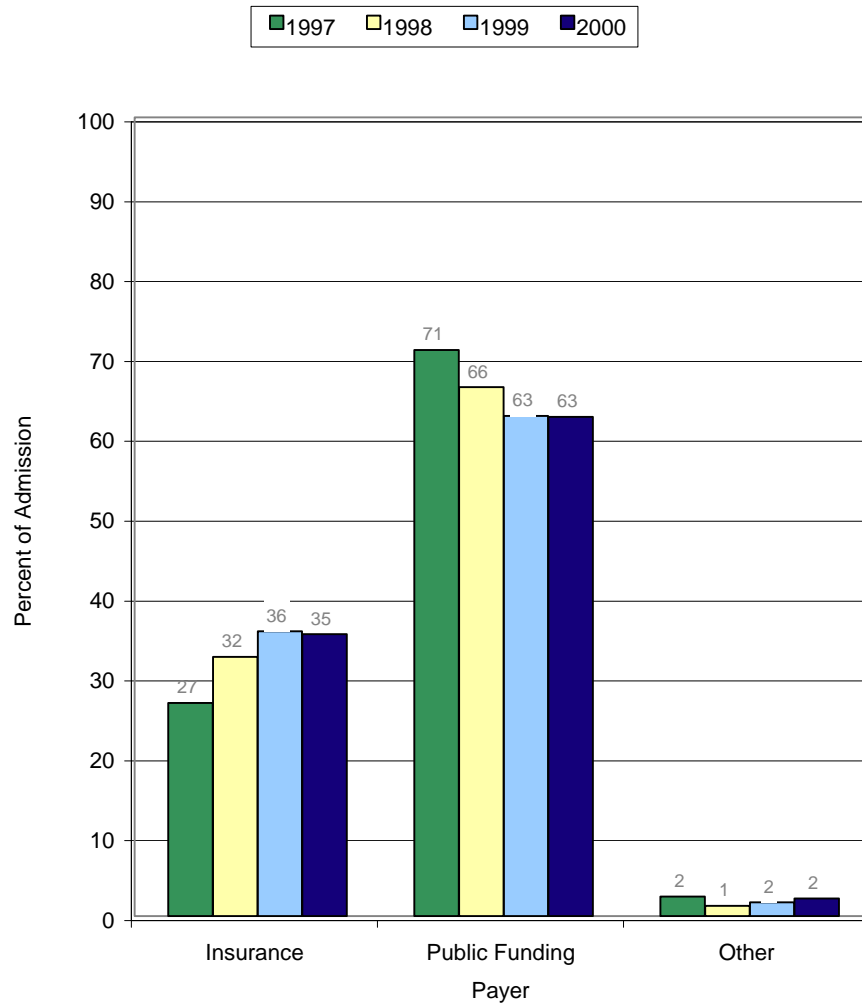

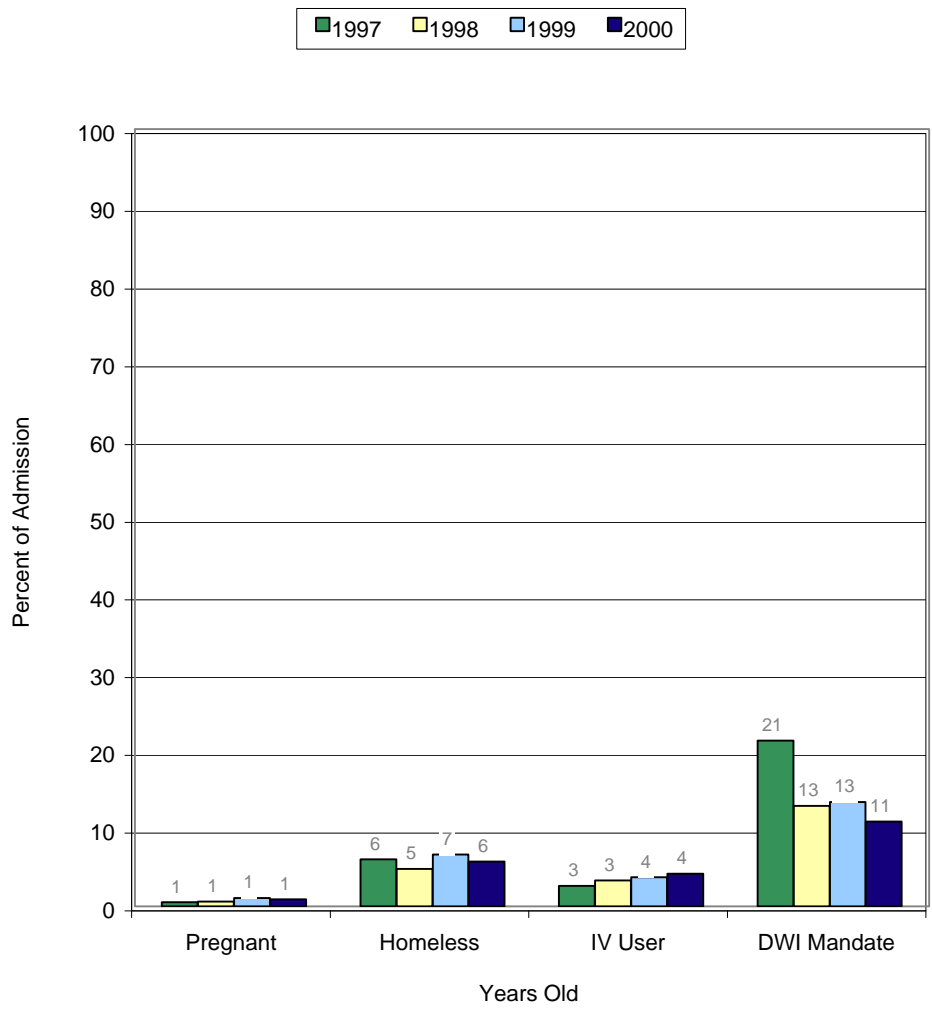

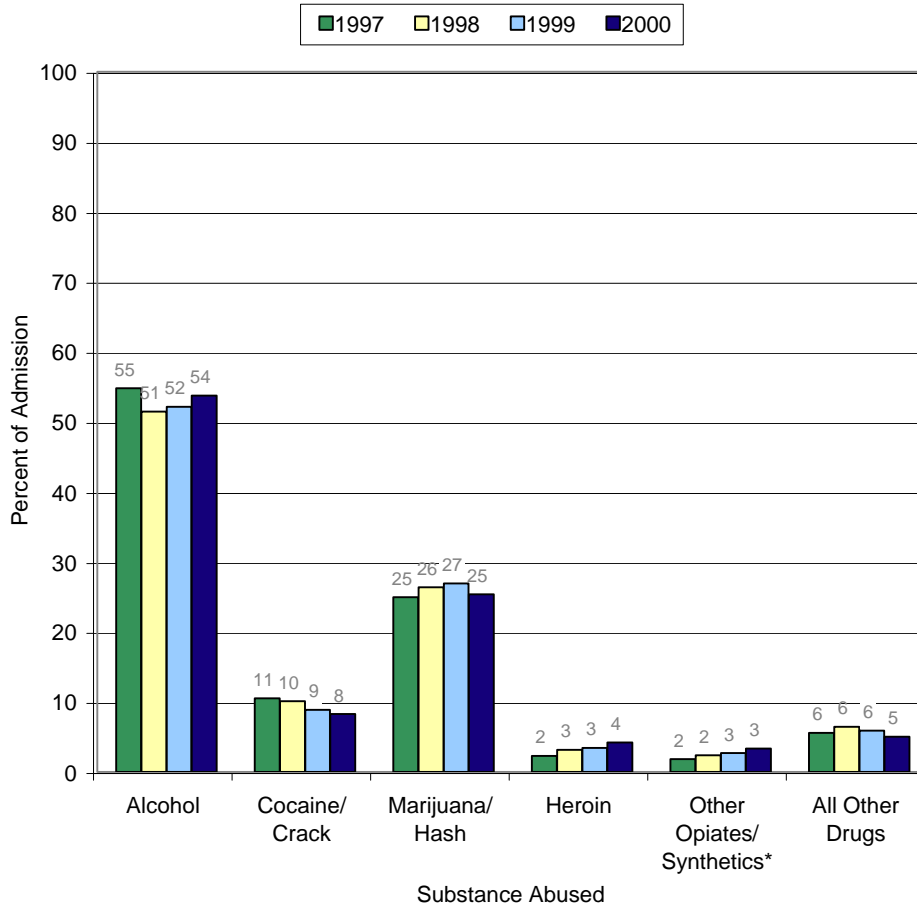

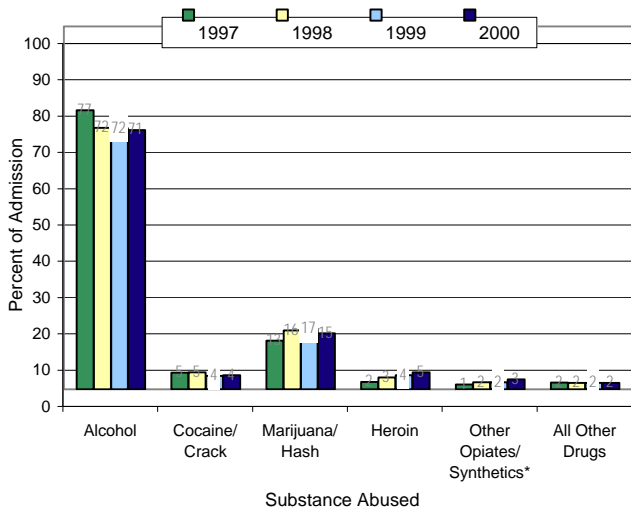
Total Substances Abused by Percentage Reported at Admissions and Fiscal Year

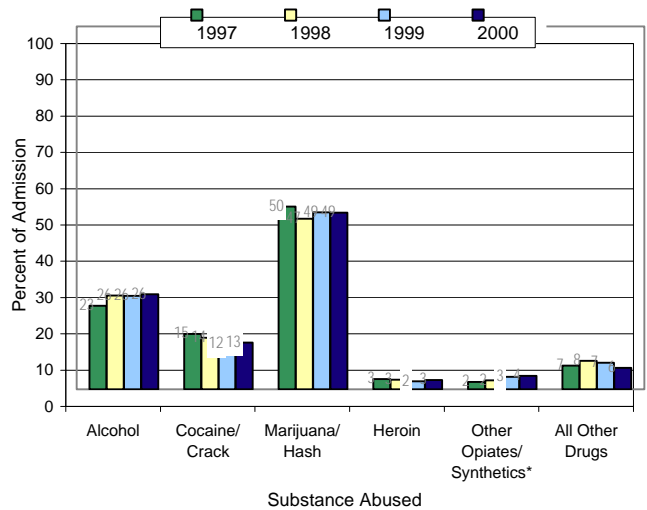

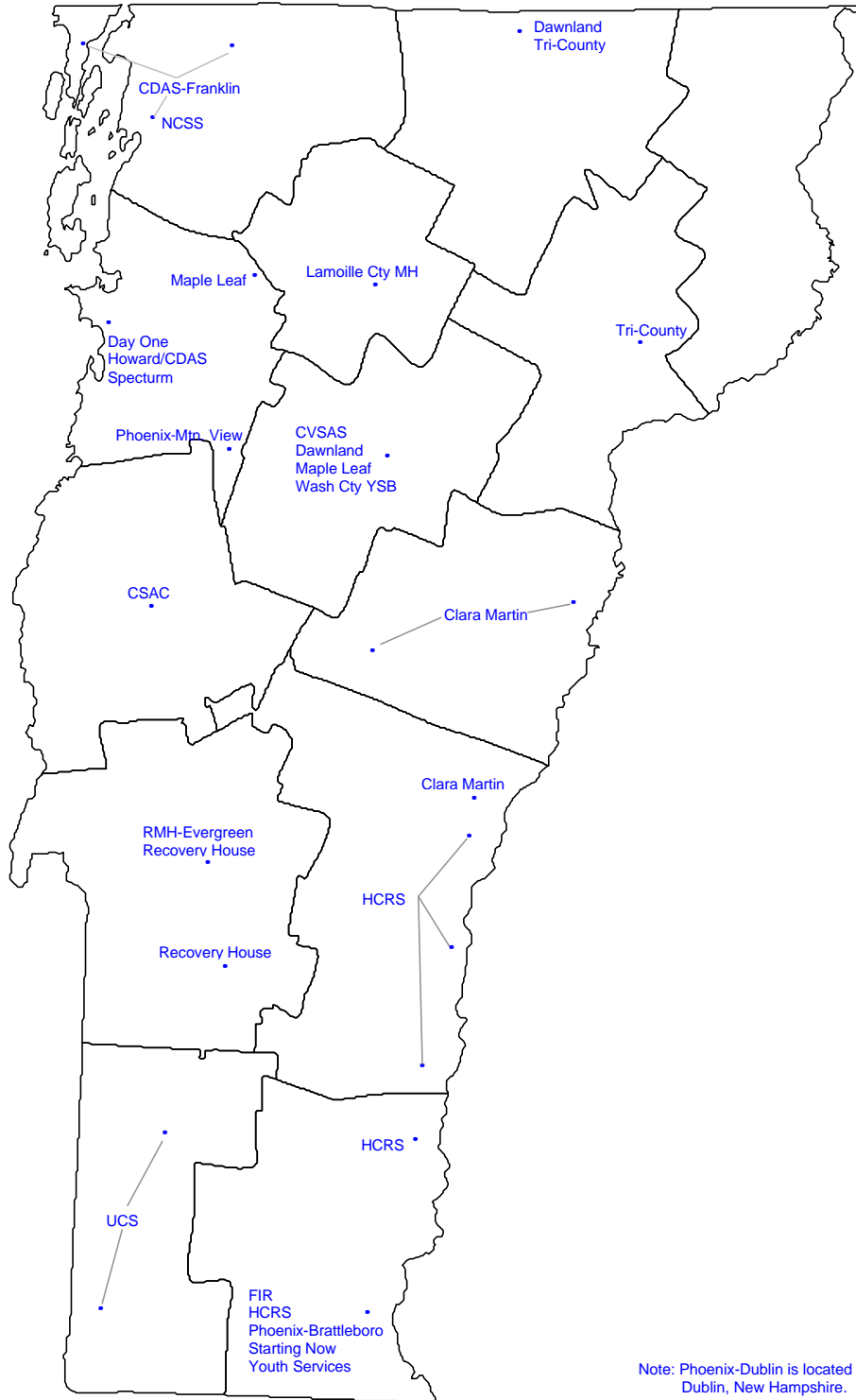

Definitions of Service Levels:

Outpatient: Treatment typically combines individual counseling, group counseling, family counseling, and self-help meetings such as AA. AA. Clients meet with counselors an average of once or twice a week.

Intensive Outpatient: Treatment is fairly intensive (i.e., three to four hours per day, three or four days per week), but provided in an outpatient setting. It is an attractive alternative for people who cannot afford residential care due to job or family obligations.

Residential: Treatment is highly structured and takes place in a residential facility for up to 21 days for adults, and up to 90 days for adolescents.

*Howard also has a short term residential program at ACT1, although data for that program is not listed in this report.

*NCSS only reported data for the first quarter, since they were not required to report data the rest of the fiscal year.

*Phoenix encompasses what was formerly none as Marathon, Inc.

*Recovery House includes both Serenity House (Residential) and Grace House (Halfway).

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
