**NOTICE OF SPECIFICATION OF CHARGES
AND NOTICE OF HEARING**

Enclosed are the Specification of Charges dated June 10, 2005, that have been filed by the Vermont Board of Medical Practice against Peter J. McKenna, M.D., Respondent. The enclosed document has been served on you pursuant to 26 V.S.A. §§ 1356 and 1357 and Board Rules 15.1(c) and 16.1. Respondent may file a written response with the Board to these charges within 20 days of the date of this notice and service. An evidentiary hearing on the merits shall be scheduled not earlier than 30 days after service of these charges upon the Respondent. The parties will be notified as to the time and location of the hearing. At such hearing, a stenographic record of the proceeding will be kept; Respondent will have the opportunity to appear personally and to have counsel present, with the right to produce witnesses and evidence in his own behalf; to cross-examine witnesses testifying against him; and to examine such documentary evidence as may be produced against him.

Please take further notice that pursuant to 26 V.S.A. § 1353 and Board Rule 16.3, the Board may schedule a pre-hearing conference in order to set a schedule by which pre-hearing matters shall be completed. The parties will be notified as to the time and location of the pre-hearing conference.
