Notice of Hearing

Please take notice that pursuant to the authority vested in the State of Vermont, Board of Medical Practice by Title 26, Chapters 7, 23 and 31, and by Title 3, Chapter 25, a hearing will be held before the Vermont Board of Medical Practice, Vermont Department of Health, 108 Cherry Street, Burlington, Vermont, at 9:30 a.m., September 29, 2003, in conference room 1A. The hearing shall continue from time to time as necessary. This hearing shall be held to consider whether the Vermont Board of Medical Practice should take disciplinary action against Lawrence S. Krain, MD, for alleged violations of Title 26, Chapter 7, 23 or 31, as applicable. Said alleged violations were previously set forth in the Specification of Charges.

Said respondent shall have the opportunity to appear personally and to have counsel present, to present witnesses, evidence, and arguments on his or her own behalf, to cross-examine witnesses testifying against him or her, and to examine such documentary evidence as may be produced against him or her. Said respondent may file with the Board a written response to the Specification of Charges within 20 days of the date of service. A record of the proceeding will be kept.

If Lawrence S. Krain, MD, fails to appear for the hearing scheduled for September 29, 2003, the allegations of the charges will be treated as proved; judgment shall be entered on default; and findings of fact, conclusions of law, opinion, and default order would issue consistent with the allegations detailed in the Specification of Charges filed in this matter.
