Meaningful Use Modified Stage 2 Instructions for Eligible Hospitals:

Immunization Information Systems

Eligible Hospitals who have certified Electronic Medical Records and who intend to meet the Meaningful Use Public Health measure for Immunization Information Systems must:

- 1. Be using a 2014 Certified EHR that is HL7v2.5.1 capable.
- Enter a Vermont Health Information Exchange (VHIE) services agreement with Vermont Information Technology Leaders (VITL). Link to VHIE Services Agreement Request Form: https://www.vitl.net/HIErequest.
- 3. Follow the Implementation Guide posted on VDH MU website to create HL7 messages for the Immunization Information Systems Public Health Measure.
- 4. Prior to or within 60 days after the start of your Modified Stage 2 reporting period register your intent to submit data with the Department of Health (click here for the Registration form).
- 5. Submit Registration Form to the Department of Health via e-mail only: AHS.VDHPHMeaningfulUse@vermont.gov
- 6. You will receive an invitation from VDH to begin testing once you have an interface in place with VITL.
- 7. Once an invitation is received:
 - a. Respond to VDH's invitation within 30 days to remain in 'good standing'.
 - b. Submit test messages to be validated by VITL and VDH.
 - c. Correct errors in test messages when requested by VITL and VDH.
 - d. Continue ongoing submission of HL7 messages.

Electronic Lab Reporting and Syndromic Surveillance

Hospitals who have a 2014 Certified EHR and who intend to meet Meaningful Use Public Health measures for Electronic Lab Reporting and Syndromic Surveillance must:

- 1. Follow the Implementation Guides posted on VDH MU website to create HL7 messages for the Electronic Lab Reporting and Syndromic Surveillance Public Health Measures.
- 2. Prior to and within 60 days after the start of your Modified Stage 2 reporting period register your intent to submit data with the Department of Health (click here for the Registration form).
- 3. Submit Registration form to the Department of Health via e-mail only: AHS.VDHPHMeaningfulUse@vermont.gov
- 4. Wait for invitation from VDH to start the onboarding process for each measure.
- 5. Once an invitation is received:
 - a. Respond to VDH's invitation within 30 days to remain in 'good standing'.
 - b. Submit test messages to be validated by VDH.
 - c. Correct errors in test messages when requested by VDH.
 - d. Continue ongoing submission of HL7 messages.
