

What is a WIC Activity?

A WIC Activity renews your WIC Food Benefits! You must complete a WIC activity within three months after your WIC appointment. Pick one activity from the list below to get your benefits for three more months.

WIC APPROVED ACTIVITIES

- WIChealth.org: Go online to complete an activity! Call the WIC Office to get your Household ID#
- SNACKtivity: Drop-in to the WIC Office on the first Thursday of the month from 11:00am-1:00pm. Receive a pass to the Echo Center for your participation! *while supplies last
- **Fluoride Clinics:** Schedule a fluoride application with our Dental Hygienist.
- <u>Aspire Together Program</u>: Attend a Well Pregnancy or Parenting Class to receive credit for your WIC Activity. Call Aspire Together at (802)658-2184 for more information.
- La Leche League: Call (802)879-3000 for dates and locations of meetings to support mothers in breastfeeding.
- Prenatal/Postpartum Breastfeeding Classes: Contact our Breastfeeding Peer Counselor, Jessica LaClair, for more information at (802)373-7074.
- <u>Grocery Store Shopping Tour:</u> Having trouble shopping with your WIC card? Call us to set up a shopping tour at your local store.
- Pennywise Pantry: Sign-up at <u>www.citymarket.coop/calendar</u>. (Promotional code: healthyfamilies) or stop by the store to register!
- **EFNEP Nutrition Classes:** Are you enrolled in the Expanded Food & Nutrition Education Program? Talk to you program facilitator to get credit for completing your WIC activity!

- Head Start: Call WIC and let us know that your child participates in a Head Start Classroom.
- **<u>Rise VT</u>**: Watch and participate in a video on physical activity! Search <u>Rise VT</u> on YouTube to find the Rise VT channel and call WIC with the WIC activity code to receive credit.
