TECHNICAL NOTES: All rates are age adjusted to the 2000 U.S. standard population and exclude basal cell and squamous cell skin cancers. Incidence rates exclude in situ carcinomas except urinary bladder. Incidence data were coded using the International Classification of Disease for Oncology (ICD-O) coding system. Vermont cases include Vermont residents only. The Vermont and U.S. incidence rates are based on the Vermont Cancer Registry, Vermont Department of Health (1994-2015) and the NPCR and SEER Incidence - U.S. Cancer Statistics Public Use Database, Nov 2017 submission (2001-2015). A reporting delay by Department of Veterans Affairs (VA) has resulted in incomplete reporting of VA hospital cases in 2011-2014.

The Vermont and the U.S. mortality rates are based on the Vermont Vital Statistics System, Vermont Department of Health (1994-2015) and the SEER Program Mortality - Aggregated Total U.S. (1990-2015).

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
