On June 1, 2022, the Vermont Department of Health published a new and improved 'Do Not Resuscitate/Clinician Orders for Life-Sustaining Treatment (DNR/COLST)' form for use across the state.

## HAN Message Type Definitions

*Health Alert:* Conveys the highest level of importance; warrants immediate action or attention. *Health Advisory:* Provides important information for a specific incident or situation may not require immediate action.

*Health Update:* Provides updated information regarding an incident or situation; unlikely to require immediate action.

*Info Service Message:* Provides general correspondence from VDH, which is not necessarily considered to be of an emergent nature.
