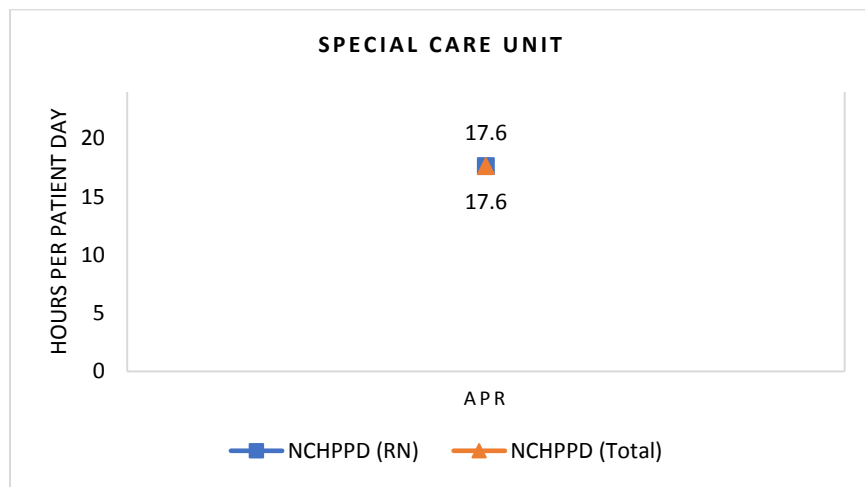


## BRATTLEBORO MEMORIAL HOSPITAL Special Care Unit

In May 2017, the merging of the Special Care Unit and Med/Surg Unit on the same floor was completed. This report reflects the SCU for the month of April, until merged. The SCU had 5 licensed beds. Types of services provided in this setting included care of people with, or at risk of developing life-threatening problems, and pediatrics. Starting May 2017, the newly integrated unit will be reported as “Progressive Care Unit” (PCU).

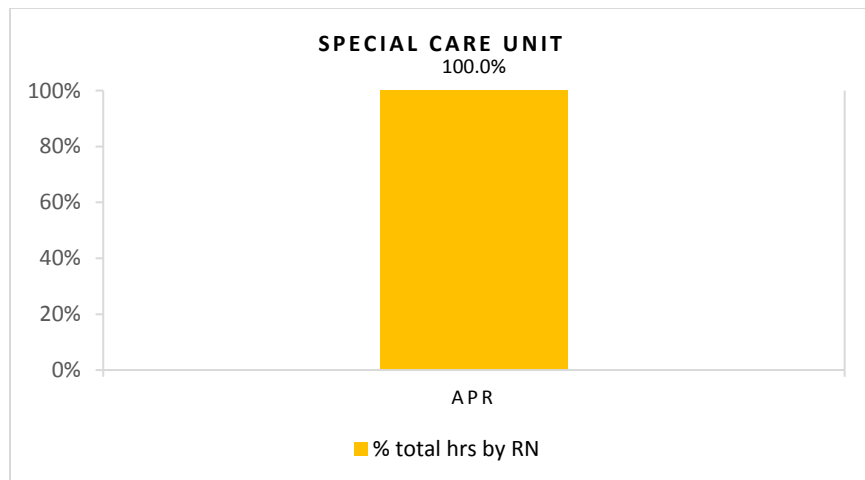
### Nursing Care Hours per Patient Day (NCHPPD): April 2017

### Percent of Total Nursing Care Hours Provided by RNs: April 2017

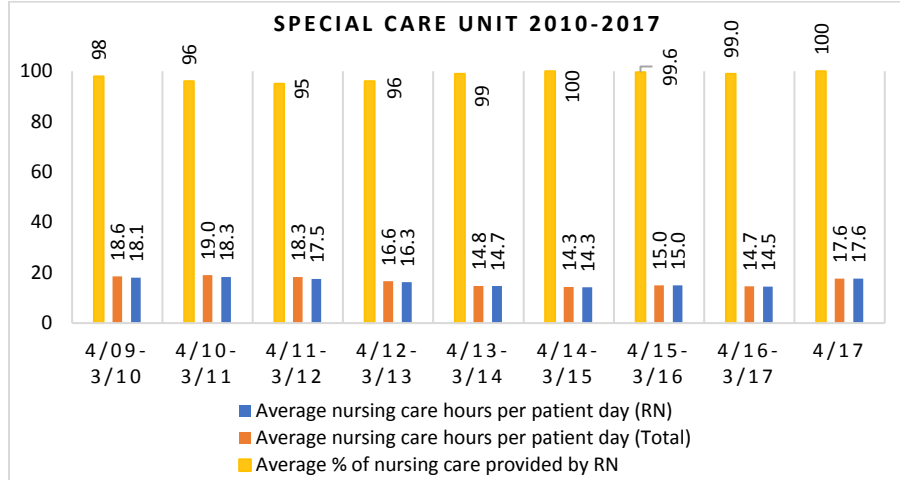
This graph shows the percentage of total nursing hours provided by RNs each month. Average for this period is 100.0%.

The graph below shows trend over time on the average RN and total nursing care hours per patient days, and average percentage of nursing care that was provided by RN.

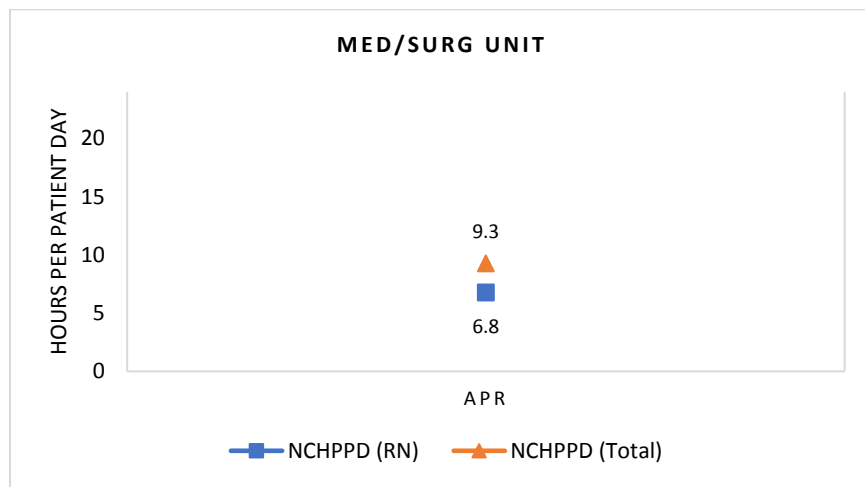

**Medical/Surgical Unit**

In May 2017, some of the Medical/Surgical beds and Special Care Unit on the same floor merged to form a “Progressive Care Unit”. This report reflects the Medical/Surgical Unit for the month of April 2017, until merged. This unit had 28 licensed beds and cared for patients age 15 and up. Types of services provided in this setting included care of people with general medical and surgical problems, heart monitoring, and end-of-life care.

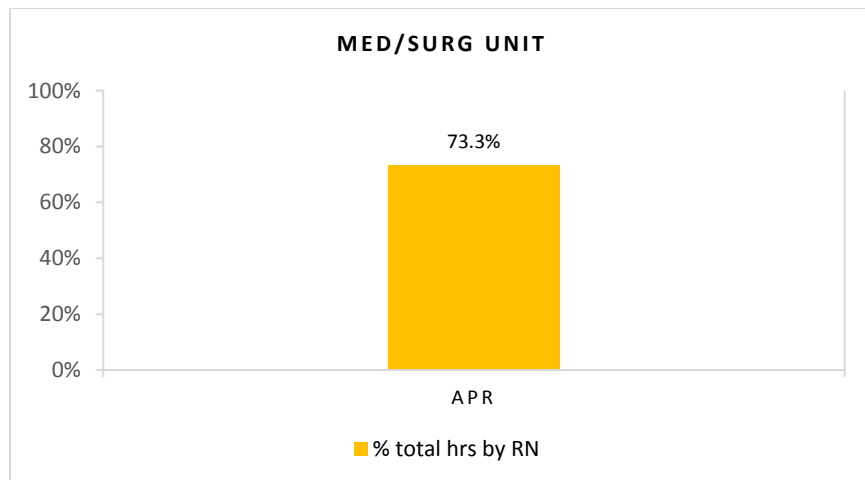
**Nursing Care Hours per Patient Day (NCHPPD): April 2017**
