




**HOW TO RECORD A 12-LEAD IN SIREN ELITE**

In the old SIREN, you could record a 12-Lead in the procedures list, or in the “Add EKG” section within the Vitals/Treatment tab. In the new SIREN Elite, the 12-Leads have been taken out of the procedure list, so you will record all your 12-leads in the ECG grids on the Treatment Panel, located within the Provider Action section.



There are two ECG grids on this treatment tab:



This one is for services who have their cardiac monitors linked to their run form

If your cardiac monitor is linked with your run form, all your 12-lead data, as well as defibrillation and vitals information collected by the monitor, will appear in this “AED/Cardiac Monitor Imports” grid. Please do not record 12-leads, or any other information, twice in two different places.

Please do not record 12-leads, or any other information, twice in two different places.
