Hand Sanitizer Available to Emergency Service Organizations June 2, 2020

The State of Vermont will be making free hand sanitizer available to emergency service organizations beginning Wednesday, June 3rd. There is a limited supply, therefore, each organization is limited to one gallon and it is required that you reserve yours by <u>clicking here</u>.

After making your request online, you will receive confirmation of your order. Containers are available in limited quantities, so you are encouraged to bring a clean container with you. You can also arrange to have another department pick up your supply. The sanitizer can be picked up on weekdays between 12:00 p.m. and 3:00 p.m. at the following locations:

Vermont Fire Academy 93 Davison Drive, Pittsford

Vermont Urban Search and Rescue/Haz-Mat Warehouse 384 US Route 7 South, Milton

The Center for Disease Control recommends the following for hand hygiene: clean hands often, including immediately after removing gloves and after contact with someone who is ill, by washing hands with soap and water for 20 seconds. If soap and water are not available and hands are not visibly dirty, use an alcohol-based hand sanitizer that contains at least 60% alcohol. However, if hands are visibly dirty, always wash hands with soap and water.
