- VT PARAMEDIC LICENSE or ability to obtain at the time of hire (VT requires NREMT)
  - Preferred critical care certification (IBSC CCP-C or FPC; UMBC CCEMT-P) for VT CCP endorsement.

- AHA BLS PROVIDER or Instructor and AHA ACLS PROVIDER or Instructor
- HIGH SCHOOL DIPLOMA or General Education Diploma (GED)
