Hardwick Rescue began in 1967 as an all-volunteer agency. In the past 20 years, volunteer decline and increased demand for services has required us to supplement our volunteer personnel with professional employees to ensure essential emergency medical services are maintained for the eight towns we serve (Hardwick, Stannard, Walden, Wheelock, Greensboro, Woodbury, Craftsbury, Wolcott).

Our agency attends approximately 800 emergencies a year. Many of our volunteers have been life-long residents of the area and have a strong drive to provide the best possible prehospital care to their neighbors. Our EMS station is conveniently located along the Lamoille Valley Rail Trail, the Hardwick Trails system. Our downtown includes several restaurants, stores, and a gym. Hardwick is also conveniently located near the Craftsbury Outdoor Center and several alpine ski resorts.
