Position Summary

This part-time medical professional is responsible for providing medical coverage for The Putney School athletic teams and opponents during home athletic contests. The schedule varies significantly during the academic year, with most of the shifts being 2-4 hours long on Saturday afternoons. Depending on level of training and interest there is a possibility for additional *per diem* and summer work. This professional medical position is an integral part of a team that is responsible for providing health services to The Putney School student community.

Essential Responsibilities

- Provide coverage for "home" athletic events
 - Provide first aid and emergency care as needed.
 - Assess for concussion and provide appropriate treatment and/or referral.
 - Work with coaches and school staff to ensure a safe playing environment (weather, equipment, and playing field).
 - o Communicate with coaches about injuries and the participation of their athletes.

• Document any injuries and communicate with nursing staff to ensure continuity of care.
