

EMS Continuing Education

Tactical Emergency Casualty Care v.2.0



Description: This 16 hour course was developed by the NAEMT's Prehospital Trauma Life Support Committee. It is based on the Tactical Combat Casualty Care (TCCC) using lessons learned from the military that are applied to the civilian world of tactical medicine.

Participants will learn to evaluate unsafe scenes, provide immediate lifesaving care-under-fire, and to extract victims for further treatment in the cold zone. Considerations are made for active shooter, multiple casualty scenarios, and self-rescue.

This course is intended for first responders and hospital personnel including EMS, firefighters, police, nursing staff, and security.
