

Screening for Dr. Dynasaur

Medicaid provides health insurance to eligible adults, children, pregnant people, the elderly, and people with disabilities. [Dr. Dynasaur](#) is a Vermont Medicaid program for qualifying children and youth under 19 and pregnant people. **Did you know?** Having Medicaid as secondary insurance can eliminate copays and help with deductible costs.

Benefits of children having Medicaid (even as secondary insurance)

Your child and family may benefit from additional coverage such as:



- Comprehensive coverage for medical and dental needs while eliminating most out of pocket costs (ex. sick visit copays and many over-the-counter medications).
- Access to Medicaid eligible programming (ex. WIC, Strong Families Vermont, Children's Personal Care, Hardship Mileage Program, etc.)

Does my child qualify?

Eligibility is determined by household income. If your pre-tax monthly income is close to or below the amount below, your child may qualify.

2	\$5,717.20	\$68,606.40
3	\$7,217.85	\$86,614.20
4	\$8,718.50	\$104,622.00

If you have a child with a disability and are over income for Dr. Dynasaur, there may be another way to access Medicaid through Disabled Children's Home Care (often called Katie Beckett). For more information about clinical eligibility and applying, call 1-855-9600.
