## **Appointments and Care Team**



Your doctor may refer you or your child to a genetics clinic if a condition is suspected or diagnosed. A genetics appointment can help explain health or developmental concerns, understand test results, and plan for the future.

#### What to expect at a genetics appointment:

- A review of your medical and family history, a physical exam, and sometimes the option for genetic testing.
- The genetics team may include several different types of health-care professionals, including genetic doctors, genetic counselors, and social workers.
- Genetic specialists can provide information regarding testing options and results.

Genetic testing and care may have out-of-pocket costs. Assistance options include:

- VFN Family Support Fund
- Designated Agencies have Flexible Family Funding and Family Managed Respite for those that qualify. <u>Click here to find your local Designated Agency.</u>
- If you do not already have Medicaid, <u>check to see if your child is eligible for secondary insurance to expand coverage</u> (see MAGI Threshold table on right). <u>Apply here</u> for Dr. Dynasaur/Medicaid.
