

State-supplied influenza vaccine availability for the 2023-24 season

- Practices enrolled in the Vermont Children's Vaccine Program (VCVP) must participate in the state-supplied pediatric (6 months through 18 years) flu vaccine program.
- Practices enrolled in the Vermont Adult Vaccine Program (VAVP) **are not** required to receive the state-supplied adult (19 64 years) vaccine.
- The state-supplied flu vaccine will **not** be available for adults 65 years and older for the 2023-24 season.
- Several brands of inactivated influenza vaccine quadrivalent (IIV4) will be available. By early April, the <u>Vaccine Availability</u> list will include the product name, NDC, CPT, and CVX codes of state-supplied flu vaccines.
- All products are single dose (either prefilled syringe or vial) and preservative-free.
- Products will display in your VIMS catalog in late August to order, and brands may change throughout the season.

Notify the program no later than 1/30/23 if changing participation in the state-supplied adult flu vaccine program for the 2023-24

- **Do not contact the program if there is no change** (e.g. your facility received VAVP flu vaccine this season and plans to participate again next season.)
- Ensure that your choice aligns with your umbrella organization if your practice is a member of a practice group or affiliated with a hospital.
