The following information must be documented for each vaccination:

- Date of administration
- Name of vaccine administered
- Vaccine manufacturer and lot number
- Name and title of person who administered the vaccine
- Address of clinic where the vaccine was given
- Date the VIS is given
- Publication date of the VIS (found at the bottom of the VIS)

Vaccines for Children (VFC) eligibility screening is federally required for patients ages 0-18 years and should be recorded by the vaccine administrator.

Federal VFC-eligible children (ages 0-18):

- Medicaid insured
- No insurance
- Underinsured-health insurance coverage does not include vaccines or only covers select vaccines
- American Indian or Alaska Native

State vaccine eligible adults (ages 19+):

• Ages 19-64 years. At this time individuals in this category can get state-supplied vaccine if Vermont remains a universal vaccine provider. This is subject to change due to funding.
