

2026 Vermont Physician License Renewal



If you want to be assured that your renewal application will be reviewed before your license expires on 11/30/2026, you **MUST** submit your renewal application and fee **no later than 11/13/2026**.

It is your responsibility to check the status of your renewal and use the deficiencies button in your VtBMPOnline account to see what's

needed.

We have a new IT system, VtBMPOnline.

Unless you have created a new account in VtBMPOnline since April 1, 2026 in response to our prior announcements, you will need to create a new account.

Any accounts from the system used prior to April 1, 2026 will not work.

- Physicians will need to enter their CME credits and upload certificates into the new portal. The only exception is for physicians newly licensed on or after December 1, 2025. Please make sure to have your certificates scanned into PDF documents and ready to upload into your CME module within our system.
- In the future, you will be able to do this as you earn them and not all at once if you choose.

Note: If you are enrolled as a user of other State of Vermont systems that make use of Okta and choose to use the email address associated with that account for this system, you find you have an existing account. This includes, for example, the Electronic Death Registration System (EDRS), Electronic Birth Registration System (EBRS), Immunization Registry or Patient Profile (blood lead and developmental screening). If you are unsure if you have an account or don't know your login, please choose "Sign Up".

How to Claim a License

Under Agency Selection, use the drop down arrow to choose your license type. Only click the box for a first time applicant if you have never held a Vermont license.

Interstate Compact License Renewal (IMLCC)

- Physicians who received their Vermont medical license through the Interstate Compact must complete a 2-Step process
- You must renew your license through the compact site and then log into our online system and complete the statutory requirements through an abbreviated renewal. You will also need to upload your CME courses and certificates to your online account. The only exception is for physicians who were licensed on or after December 1, 2025.

You MUST Complete the Workforce Census Survey

The survey has become a mandatory step of the process to renew a physician license, several licensees have certified that they completed the survey, when they had not.

- **On your renewal, you will need to enter the survey code that you receive after completing the survey.**

The names of those who incorrectly certify that they have completed the survey will be provided to the Board of Medical Practice for investigation of possible unprofessional conduct.
