Opioid Abatement Settlement Fund – Projects With Legislative Intent to Continue Funding Annually

H. 218/Act 16 of 2025 included legislative intent to continue funding the following projects annually at not less than FY26 levels:

- Outreach and engagement staff \$1,976,000 (FY26 level)
- Recovery residences \$1,400,000 (FY26 level)
- Syringe services programs \$850,000 (FY26 level)
- Burlington overdose prevention center \$1,100,000 (FY26 level)
