Questions and Responses

Question #1:

The RFP (#1 Recovery Residence Offerings for Young Adults) appears to be age specific (ages 18-24). Are there any funding opportunities for youth under 18 (between 12 and 17)?

Answer:

The Vermont Department of Health does not currently have funding opportunities for recovery housing for youth under 18 (ages 12 – 17).
