

Chemical Disclosure Program Notice of Removal Form

April 2026

18 V.S.A. §1775 states that a manufacturer “may at any time submit to the Department notice that a chemical of high concern to children has been removed from the manufacturer’s children’s product or that the manufacturer no longer sells, offers for sale, or distributes in the State the children’s product containing the chemical of high concern to children.” Upon verification of a manufacturer’s notice, the program will remove from the public data any reference to the relevant children’s product of the manufacturer.
