Active Threat Integrated Response Course (PER-340)

LSU NCBRT/Academy of Counter-Terrorist Education provides Department of Homeland Security (DHS) certified courses, taught by expert instructors, and will deliver all course materials to your training facility at no-cost to your agency.

Course Summary

This course is designed to improve integration between law enforcement, fire, and emergency medical services (EMS) in active shooter events. The course provides law enforcement officers with key medical skills based on tactical emergency casualty care (TECC) guidelines that can be used at the point of injury (POI) to increase survivability of victims.

Participants will discuss rescue task forces (RTFs), basic hemorrhage control and airway management, and organization of a unified response. Additionally, participants will take part in a discipline-specific practical exercises that review skills in either law enforcement tactics or medical response. All participants will engage in large-scale practical exercises that tests all of the concepts and skills introduced and practiced throughout the course.

Target Audience

The target audience for the **Direct Delivery** version of this course includes:

- Police officers
 - Fire personnel (fire fighters)
 - EMS personnel working or volunteering for local, state, and tribal jurisdictions throughout the United States and U.S. territories
- The course is designed to accommodate 25 law enforcement officers and 15 fire or EMS providers.
