# **Vermont State Health Improvement Plan 2019-2023: Trends in Tobacco Measures June** 2025


The <u>State Health Improvement Plan (SHIP)</u>, active from 2019 to 2023, included seven tobacco-related measures to monitor tobacco use among Vermont adults and youth for progress toward plan goals. Five of seven measures were met during these 5 years. The goals for the SHIP are drafted from the 2018 State Health Assessment, utilizing data from 2017 and earlier years. While this iteration of the SHIP is complete, the program remains committed to improving these measures. 
Percent of adults with disabilities who currently smoke cigarettes (VT BRFSS) $^{\Omega^*}$ 




Percent of LGBTQ+ adults who currently smoke cigarettes (VT BRFSS)<sup>Ω\*</sup>

Percent of adults with depression who currently smoke cigarettes (VT BRFSS) $^{\Omega^*}$ 










- \*: Adult cigarette smoking prevalence is age-adjusted to the U.S. 2000 population.
- ‡: Caution should be used when comparing 2021 YRBS data with other years due to changes in survey timing due to the COVID-19 pandemic. This is indicated with a break in the trendline. In addition, the 2021 rate for any tobacco product use among LGBTQ+ youth cannot be compared with prior years as the question methodology changed.
