## 2026 Hospital Report Card – Vermont Hospital Information

Founded in 1933, [Mt. Ascutney Hospital and Health Center](#) (MAHHC) is a not-for-profit community hospital network in Vermont, including the critical access-designated Mt. Ascutney Hospital and Health Center, Historic Homes of Runnemedede, a senior residential care campus in Windsor, and the Ottauquechee Health Center in Woodstock. A member of the Dartmouth Health system, MAHHC provides comprehensive primary and specialty care and 35 inpatient beds, 10 of which include its nationally recognized Acute Rehabilitation Center. As the largest employer in the area, MAHHC acknowledges its employees as its greatest asset and has been recognized by the Governor's Office with Excellence in Worksite Wellness awards and for its consistent performance as one of the top-ranked hospitals in northern New England for employee engagement. MAHHC is at the hub of a vast community resource network that has partnered to cover service gaps and improve population health. The Hospital is overall dedicated to providing local, trusted care and being a partner in health.

Mt. Ascutney Hospital and Health Center's acute physical medicine Rehabilitation Center is accredited by the Commission on Accreditation of Rehabilitation Facilities (CARF) for its rigorous inpatient rehabilitation, outpatient therapies, and stroke programs, helping it earn recognition as the 2024 "top rehab hospital" in Vermont, according to *Becker's Hospital Review*. The Hospital holds a Best Practice recognition by the National Rural Health Association (NRHA) for healthcare quality and is a recent recipient of the Press Ganey Human Experience Award. The National Committee for Quality Assurance (NCQA) has awarded MAHHC with Level 3 status, the highest level of medical home designation, and the Hospital was the first in Vermont to earn accreditation as a Level 2 Geriatric Emergency Department. In 2026, *Becker's Hospital Review* recognized MAHHC as one of 100 "critical access hospitals to know" for its dedication to providing primary and specialty care, improving the health of the communities it serves.
