Southwestern Vermont Medical Center (SVMC), a member of Dartmouth Health, is a non-profit, general medical surgical hospital located in Bennington, Vermont. It is licensed for 99-beds. SVMC is the only hospital in Bennington County and also serves western Windham County, Vermont, eastern Rensselaer and Washington Counties in New York, and northern Berkshire County in Massachusetts. SVMC has earned six consecutive designations from the American Nurses Credentialing Center's (ANCC) Magnet Recognition Program and is the only hospital in Vermont to have a nurse residency that has received "Accreditation with Distinction" from the ANCC Practice to Transition Program. SVMC is accredited by the Joint Commission and has more than 130 board-certified physicians on its medical staff, including primary care and pediatrics, surgery, OB-gyn, orthopedics, endocrinology, cardiology, pulmonology, gastroenterology, oncology, and infectious disease.
