
Medical/Surgical Unit



This graph shows the percentage of total nursing hours provided by RNs each month. The yearly average for this period is 75.67%.








Percent of Total Nursing Care Hours Provided by RNs: April 2023 – March 2024


Inpatient Psychiatric Unit



This graph shows the percentage of total nursing hours provided by RNs each month. The yearly average for this period is 77.76%.




Yearly Average of RN and Total Nursing Care Hours per Patient Day: 2017 - 2024





This graph shows the percentage of total nursing hours provided by RNs each month. The yearly average for this period is 99.45%.




Yearly Average of RN and Total Nursing Care Hours per Patient Day: 2017 - 2024





This graph shows the percentage of total nursing hours provided by RNs each month. The yearly average for this period is 85.23%.






Yearly Average of RN and Total Nursing Care Hours per Patient Day: 2017 - 2024




Inpatient Rehabilitation Unit

The Inpatient Rehabilitation Unit has 35 licensed beds. It provides care for people who require 24-hour physician availability, 24-hour nursing care, and the skill of at least two different therapies, and can tolerate at least three hours of therapy for five days a week. Its focus is on helping people to achieve a level of independence to safely leave our acute care setting and continue his/her recovery at home or in some instances, at a subacute pace.



This graph shows the percentage of total nursing hours provided by RNs each month. The yearly average for this period is 74.89%.



Yearly Average of RN and Total Nursing Care Hours per Patient Day: 2017 - 2024







This graph shows the percentage of total nursing hours provided by RNs each month. The yearly average for this period is 90.64%.






Yearly Average of RN and Total Nursing Care Hours per Patient Day: 2017 - 2024
