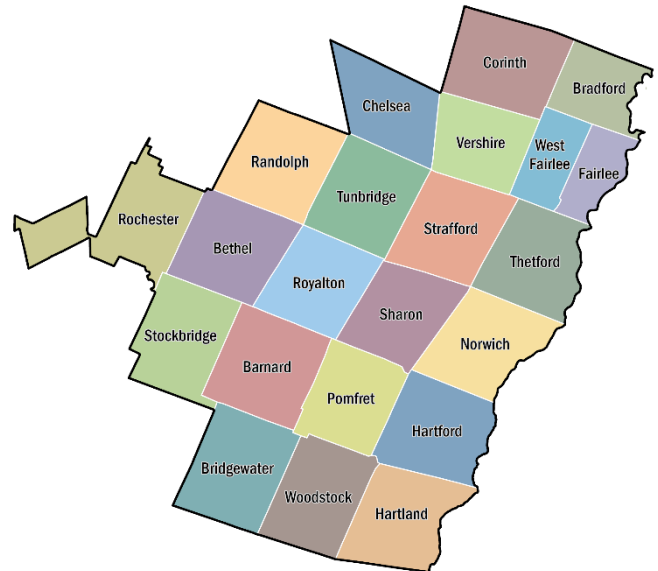


Who We Are

Increasing Oral Health Care Access

Our Chronic Disease Specialist brings together dental and public health workers through the Upper Valley Oral Health Workgroup to address barriers to dental care access. In September 2025, the group teamed up with dental providers, The Upper Valley Medical Reserve Corps, and a local Rotary Club to organize a free Dental Care Pop-up Clinic in Hartford. This clinic provided dental care to individuals who typically cannot access it.

Supporting Substance Use Prevention and Recovery

Vermont's Prevention Lead Organization gave over \$800,000 to 18 groups in Orange, Windsor, Windham, and Bennington Counties. In the White River Junction Health District, groups like the Hartford Community Coalition, Clara Martin Center, Second Growth, and the Valley Court Diversion Programs used the funds to support projects including youth centers, youth diversion classes, and school programs.

White River Junction Local Health Programs



WIC Program

Pregnant people and children under 5 who participate in Medicaid/Dr. Dynasaur/Green Mountain Care insurance, 3SquaresVT, or Reach Up are automatically eligible for the program. Provides supplemental foods, nutrition education, breastfeeding support and promotion, to pregnant and post-partum people and children under 5.



Family and Child Health

Vermont families enrolled in Medicaid can enroll in a variety of Children's Integrated Services programs prenatally through age 6. Our local FCH coordinator can help direct to one of the local agencies providing home visiting, breastfeeding supports, pediatric therapies and more.



School Health

Collaborates with school nurses, administrators, and local health care providers to improve the health and well-being of school-aged children.



Emergency Preparedness

Assists local communities with public health emergency planning and response.



Healthy Homes & Lead Poisoning Prevention

Connects community members to resources that help ensure a safe and healthy home environment.



Immunizations

Works with families and medical practices to increase the number of people who receive recommended vaccines.



Chronic Disease

The Chronic Disease Designee partners with local organizations to improve chronic disease outcomes and reduce health disparities through community health initiatives on topics such as oral health and Worksite Wellness.



Substance Use Prevention

Local Health staff and prevention consultants collaborate with community partners to carry out effective substance misuse prevention efforts.
