

Immunization schedule of vaccines required for child care

Age when enrolling:	Vaccines:
2 – 3 months	1 each of: DTaP, Hep B, polio, Hib, PCV
4 – 5 months	2 each of: DTaP, Hep B, polio, Hib, PCV
6 – 14 months	3 each of: DTaP, Hep B, polio, Hib, PCV
15 – 17 months	3 each of: DTaP, Hep B, polio 1–4 doses each of: Hib and PCV 1 each of: MMR and varicella
18 months – 4 years	4 DTaP, 3 each of: Hep B and polio 1–4 doses each of Hib and PCV 1 each of: MMR and varicella

DTaP: diphtheria, tetanus, pertussis (whooping cough)

Hep B: hepatitis B

Hib: Haemophilus influenzae type b

Varicella: chickenpox

MMR: measles, mumps, and rubella

PCV: pneumococcal

Polio: polio (IPV)

Hepatitis A, rotavirus, & influenza (flu) vaccines are strongly recommended, but are not required.
