BURLINGTON - January is Cervical Cancer Awareness Month and the Vermont Department of Health's Ladies First program, The Hicks Foundation and Planned Parenthood of Northern New England are partnering to offer a Free Pap Day for all women who are uninsured or underinsured.

The Planned Parenthood/Burlington Health Center (183 St. Paul Street) will host women's wellness exams, Pap tests, heart health screening, and HPV tests and vaccine from 9 a.m. – 1 p.m.

Free Pap Day will also be offered at Planned Parenthood/Northern New England in Newport (Newport Health Center, 79 Coventry Street, and Rutland (Rutland Health Center, 6 Roberts North from 9 a.m. – 1 p.m.

Childcare and food will be provided at no charge, with transportation arranged.
