


Past 30 Day Marijuana Use VT and US (National Survey on Drug Use and Health 2018/2019)




Concern

- The rate is nearly 20% higher than #2 (Maine).


Past Year Heroin Use VT and US (National Survey on Drug Use and Health 2018/2019)




Past Year Pain Reliever Misuse VT and US (National Survey on Drug Use and Health 2018/2019)








Past 30 Day Binge Drinking VT and US (National Survey on Drug Use and Health 2018/2019)




Past 30 Day Tobacco Use VT and US (National Survey on Drug Use and Health 2018/2019)






Past 30 Day alcohol Consumption and Binge Drinking Age 12-20 VT and US (National Survey on Drug Use and Health 2018/2019)




Alcohol Use Disorder Past YearVT and US (National Survey on Drug Use and Health 2018/2019)

BLOCK GRANT SUPPLEMENT



Division of Alcohol and Drug Programs

- December 27, 2020 President signed into law \$900 billion in COVID-Relief
- Package include \$1.65 billion in <u>supplemental funds</u> to the SAPT Block Grant
- \square 20% set-aside is maintained for prevention
- SAMHSA given permission to determine allowable activities, timelines and reporting
- □ New Administration to make the decisions

□ Anticipated increase: up to \$5.8 million

- □ 2-year spending authority
- Information from SAMHSA expected soon (as this is emergency funding)
- □ No expectation that these funds will continue
- □ New activities will need to be short-term
