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ANAPLASMOSIS is the second most common tickborne disease in Vermont. Men and women age 50 and older are especially at risk.

Over 25% of Vermonters who get anaplasmosis are hospitalized, but it is treatable. If you experience symptoms,

- » Fatigue
- » Muscle aches
- » Headache
- » Nausea or
