



CONFIGURATION PART I Software settings


Step 1– Click on the icon on your desktop called LogTag Analyzer and open the program.



Step 2– Click on “Edit” and then “Options”.




Step 3 – Click the “General Setting” and select the two settings shown in the slide.




Do not click the “OK” button until step 13 has been completed.

Step 4 – Click the “Summary Statistics” and make sure you only place a checkmark in the 3 boxes indicated in the slide.




Step 5 – Click the “Chart Statistics” and make sure you only place a checkmark in the 3 boxes indicated in the slide.




Step 7 – Click the “Automation” and place a checkmark in the boxes indicated in the slide.




Step 8 – Click the “File and Folder Settings”. These are prepopulated and you do not need to change anything unless you would like to change the location of folder where downloads will be saved.




Step 9 – Click the “Exports and Reports” and place a checkmark in the 1 box indicated on the slide (LogTag File only).




Step 10 – Click the “Date and Time”. You do not need to change anything here.
