Beginning November 1, 2022, the Vaccine Inventory Management System (VIMS) will send automated email reminders to primary and backup vaccine contacts.

- E-mails will come from <u>DoNotReply@vermont.gov</u>.
- You can not opt out of these emails. If you are actively receiving the state-supplied vaccine and any of the below criteria occur, an email will be sent.

## **Expired vaccine**

When a vaccine expires in your inventory, VIMS will send the primary and backup an email informing them. If still present, they will be asked to remove the vaccine from their unit and submit an adjustment of waste or return in VIMS. Emails are sent every 7 days until the expired vaccine is adjusted out, or a monthly reconciliation reports the vaccine as administered.

**Note:** There will be no notification of the Beyond Use Date (BUD). The BUD is the responsibility of the practice to monitor.

## **Late Monthly Reconciliation**

A full vaccine inventory reconciliation must occur monthly, regardless of the practice order schedule. If delayed, VIMS will send the primary and backup an email notification requesting reconciliation of inventory. An email will be sent every 7 days until the inventory is reconciled.

## **Depot Request**

When part of a vaccine order will be delivered to your practice via the Depot, VIMS will send the primary and back-up an e-mail notification informing you which vaccines will be included in the Depot Delivery. The Vaccine Depot will communicate with details on when to expect the delivery.
