At this time, there is a limited supply of [JYNNEOS vaccine](#) available in Vermont. JYNNEOS is not available to order but is available to your patients.

- Clinicians who suspect [hMPXV \(human monkeypox virus\)](#) should call the Infectious Disease Program at (802) 863-7240, Option 2, to speak with an epidemiologist 24/7.
- Patients [eligible for vaccination](#) may contact your office looking for this vaccine. If you have a patient who meets eligibility requirements, please contact the Health Department at (802) 863-7240, Option 0, or email [AHS.VDHImmunizationProgram@vermont.gov](mailto:AHS.VDHImmunizationProgram@vermont.gov). You will be referred to an administering location or instructed on how to obtain a dose for your patient.
