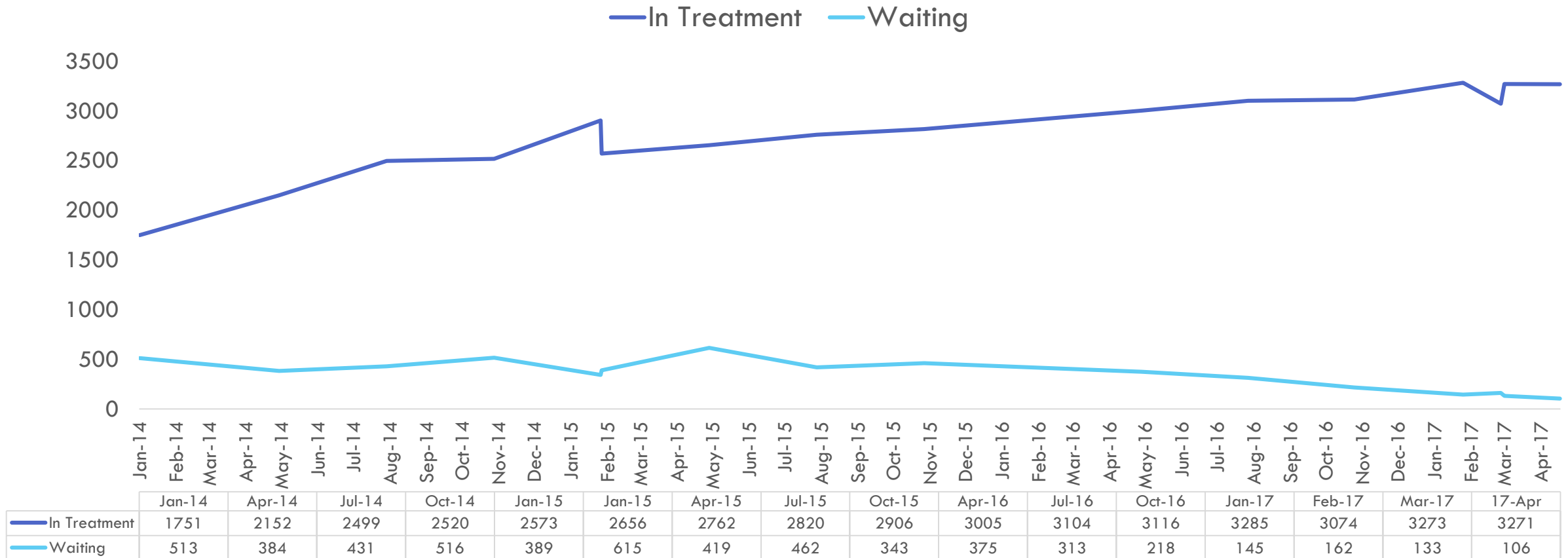

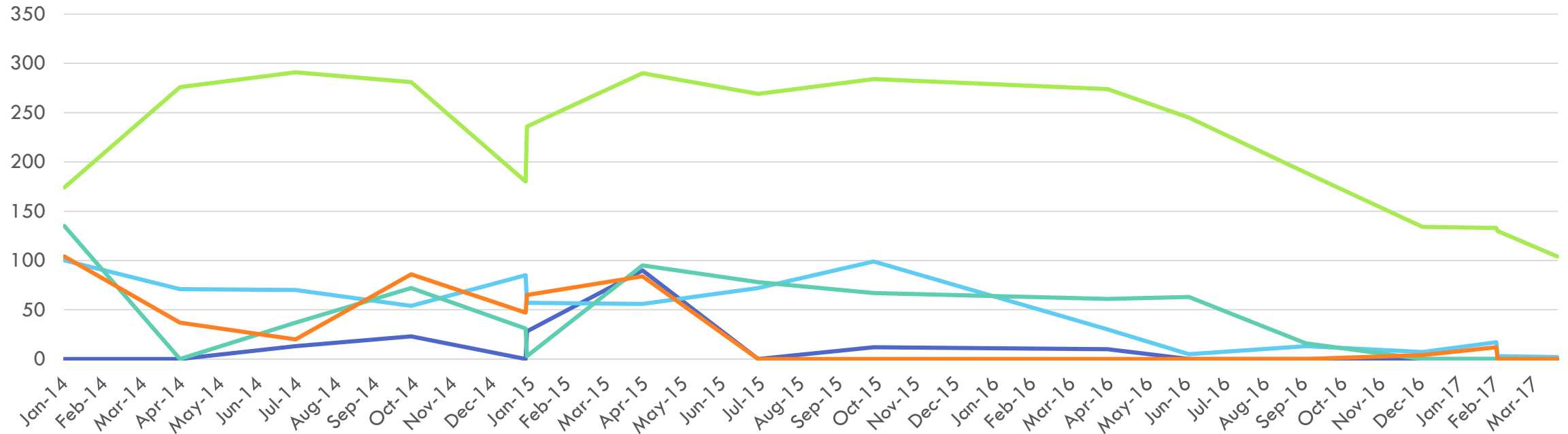

Number of People in Hubs and Waiting for Hub Services Over Time

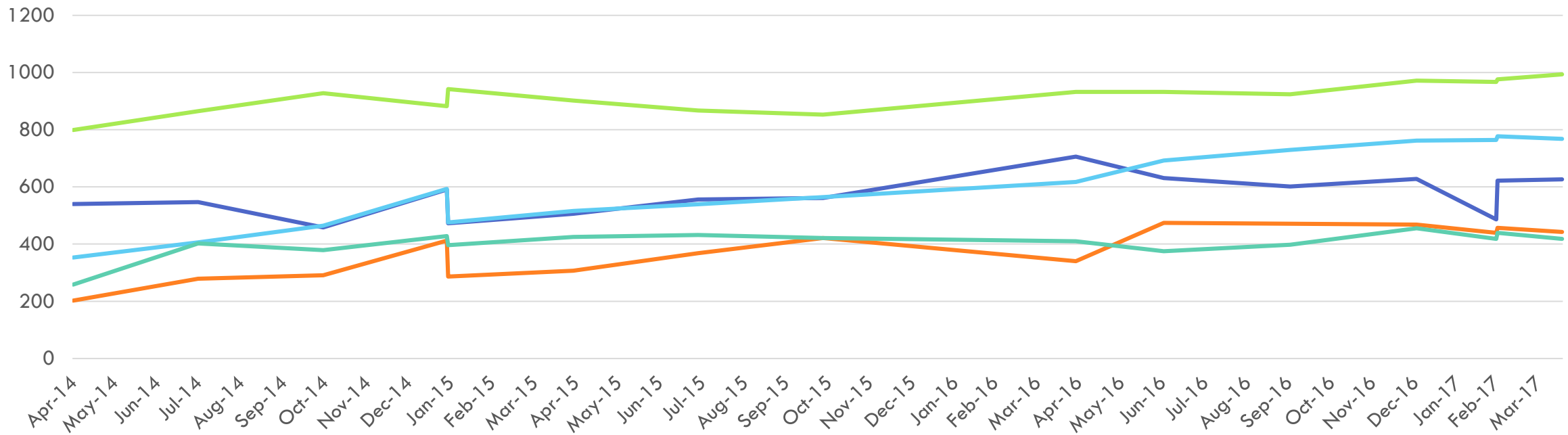


Number of People Waiting for Hub Services by Region
