Chile has extensively studied the Iceland model and will be implementing the evidence-based model in 100 cities over the next two years, led by the pediatricians and forward-thinking policy makers. Dr. Soriano is an American-trained pediatrician, gastroenterologist, hepatologist, and nutritionist in Chile.

<u>Dr. Michael Mann</u>, associate professor at Boise State University and a community intervention specialist for the Icelandic Centre for Social Research and Analysis who has worked to implement the model in West Virginia. His work emphasizes systems approaches to preventing substance abuse, supporting the development of the whole child, and promoting academic and life success.
