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SUMMARY

This report contains Vermont census counts of population for 2010, and population estimates for 2015 and 2016. Population totals for counties and towns are presented (Figures 1 and 4, Tables 2 and 3). A listing of towns ranked in order of decreasing 2016 population is provided (Table 4). In addition, the age-sex distributions for the state and counties are given (Tables 5, 6). Historical population data for Vermont counties are provided in Table 1.

The population of Vermont was estimated to be 624,594[^] on July 1, 2016 (Table 1), marginally lower than the Census 2010 count of 625,741. This is a decrease of 147 people from the 2010 census. Net migration in Vermont from 2010 to 2016 indicates an overall out-migration of 3,892 people (Table 2) since the 2010 Census. Net migration is calculated as the difference between population change and natural increase (births minus deaths). The highest growth rates occurred in Lamoille, Chittenden and Franklin Counties (Figure 3, Table 2). Rutland, Windham, and Caledonia counties show the largest rate of decline in population since 2010.

Of the 255 towns and cities in Vermont, eight had total 2016 populations that exceeded 10,000 (Figure 4, Tables 3 and 4). These eight places accounted for 24.5 percent of the state's population. Eighty-eight towns had resident populations less than 1,000 people, and three unorganized places in Essex County had no permanent residents (Avery's Gore, Lewis and Warner's Grant). Due to limitations in the data available for many towns, estimates may vary substantially from year to year. Observing the population trend for several years gives a sense of the true population picture.






Figure 2. Population Age-Sex Distribution of Vermont, 2010, 2016.

The fastest growing segment of the Vermont population is the 60-74 years old age group (Figure 2, Table 6). There has been a decline since the 2010 Census in the under 20 population, as well as in the 35-54 age group.

2010 Census Counts and 2016 Estimates**

Figure 3. Population Change by Town, 2000-2016.




Figure 4. Vermont Town Population, 2016 Estimates.
