REQUIRED SCHOOL NURSE/ASSOCIATE SCHOOL NURSE ROLES

- Take responsibility for professional development and learning that is consistent with the <u>ANA/National</u> <u>Association of School Nurses Standards of Practice</u> as well as state and federal laws pertaining to student health and wellbeing in order to provide safe care and minimize liability risks.
- Take personal responsibility for professional development and learning that is consistent with the Vermont <u>Rules Governing the Licensing of Educators and the Preparation of Educational Professionals</u> using nursing judgment, clinical assessment skills, and the nursing process.
- Maintain current license as both a Registered Nurse with the <u>Vermont Board of Nursing</u> and the Vermont Agency of Education <u>School Nurse/Associate School Nurse license endorsement</u>.
 - Reach out to SN colleagues to support collaboration and professional development in this arena.
