## Vermont's Guide to Fluoride Levels in Public Water Systems 2018 Edition

This booklet provides information on the fluoride status in public water systems in Vermont's cities and towns water supply. It is designed to assist local public health professionals, dental and medical professionals, and the public to make informed decisions about their oral health.

Virtually all water, including ground, surface, and sea water has fluoride, but the level is usually less than the optimal amount to help prevent tooth decay. Community water fluoridation is the precise adjustment of natural fluoride levels to 0.70 mg/L; the optimal level to prevent tooth decay recommended by the Department of Health and Human Services (HHS) in 2011.

Americans have access to more sources of fluoride than they did when water fluoridation was first introduced in the United States in the 1940s, including dental products such as toothpaste and mouth rinses, prescription fluoride supplements, and fluoride applied by dental or medical professionals. Water fluoridation and fluoride toothpaste are largely responsible for the significant decline in tooth decay in the U.S. over the past several decades. However, tooth decay is still a very common, chronic, preventable disease that affects all ages. Untreated tooth decay impacts employment, social development, self-esteem, and overall quality of life.

## About Vermont’s Public Water Systems

A public water supply is considered a public water system if it has a minimum of 15 service connections used by year-round residents or regularly serves at least 25 year-round residents. Examples include towns and cities, homeowners’ associations, hospitals, fire districts, mobile home parks, nursing homes, etc.

There is a total of 461 public water systems serving 451,160 Vermont residents; 29 systems adjust their fluoride level, serving 167,526 people; 41 consecutive systems buy their water from the 29 systems which serve 85,903 people; 390 systems do not adjust their fluoride levels and serve 197,680 people (Table 1). Of the Vermont residents served by a public water system, 56% are receiving fluoridated water.

**Adjusted:** A water system that adds fluoride to achieve optimal fluoride level of 0.70 mg/L. (Community Water Fluoridation).

**Natural:** A water system that has a natural fluoride concentration at or above 0.60 mg/L. No fluoride is added to the system.

**Non-Adjusted:** A water system that has a natural fluoride level at or below 0.59 mg/L. No fluoride is added.

**Consecutive:** A water system that purchases water from another water system. The consecutive water system has a water plant but does little or no treatment to the water. These water systems are optimally fluoridated if the original (i.e., parent) system is optimally fluoridated. No additional fluoride is added to the consecutive system.

**Multi-Source:** A water system that receives water from numerous sources. It may get water from two or three other water systems and provide some water itself through its own wells. The fluoridation status depends on the fluoridation status of the different water systems. No additional fluoride is added. If a water system does not fluoridate, the fluoride level must be tested at least once every 3 to 9 years according to testing requirements by the Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) and the Vermont Department of Environmental Conservation (DEC).

**How to Use this Booklet:**

Each public water system is listed in the booklet by town in alphabetical order, the population served, and the average fluoride level for 2018. Communities with fluoride levels at **0.30** parts per million (ppm) and above are **bolded** in the table (starts page 7). This booklet is updated every three years.

**The Medical and Dental HealthCare Providers responsibilities are to:**

- ✓ Determine the existing fluoride content in the families’ primary source of water prior to prescribing fluoride supplements.
- ✓ Consider the water source for infants and children in daycare facilities and school prior to prescribing supplements.
- ✓ Use this booklet to locate their town, then the water system name.
- ✓ Go to the fluoride level column where the fluoride levels will be found in parts per million (ppm). **Bolded** are the systems with fluoride levels equal to or greater than **0.30 ppm**. This will alert you to reference the dietary fluoride supplement below prior to prescribing fluoride supplements.
- ✓ Refer to the Dietary Fluoride Supplement Schedule for prescription guidelines.
- ✓ For families whose water supply is not located in this booklet, i.e. wells or small systems (under 15 connections or 25 yearly residents) and the fluoride level is unknown, they must test their water prior to obtaining a fluoride supplement prescription (See next page)

**Children should receive:**

- **One systemic source**
- **Multiple topical sources, starting at the age of 6 months for maximum effect**

**Systemic Sources**

- Community Water Fluoridation
- Natural occurring beneficial levels of fluoride in primary drinking source
- Prescription fluoride drops or tablet supplementation

**Topical Sources**

- Fluoridated toothpaste (a pea size amount for very small children)
- Over the counter fluoride mouth rinse (over the age of 6)
- Fluoride treatments and fluoride varnish in a dental and medical office

**Why test a private water supply?**

There are geographic areas in Vermont where the naturally occurring fluoride level in the groundwater exceeds the recommended guideline for fluoride of 2.0 parts per million (ppm). The Health Department recommends a reverse osmosis water filtration system to reduce fluoride exposure to a level less than 2.0 ppm in private water supplies that exceed that level.

It is very important that prescriptions are NOT written for children who may already be receiving high levels of naturally fluoridated water. The only way to know for sure is to test the well water for its level of natural fluoride BEFORE prescriptions for supplements are written.

**How to test a private water supply**

The Health Department Laboratory will test fluoride in small systems, well water or springs for families with children ages four years or younger for free. Health Department Laboratory will test fluoride for a service-fee for families with children ages five or older. Any other certified laboratory for water analysis can test for fluoride levels in the water too.

## How do I get a test kit?
